# Coldwater harriers turn back Marshall, Lakeview

**MARSHALL** — Coldwater High's cross country teams registered four victories here Wednesday with both the boys' and girls' teams winning double-dual meets from Marshall and Lakeview in Twin Valley action.

"It's always tough to beat Marshall, especially on their home course," Coldwater coach Jim Bilsborrow said, "but our kids really rose to the occasion today."

The Cardinal boys had little trouble downing Lakeview, winning 21-34, but they just edged the host Redskins 27-28.

Scott Gleason, Brian Licht, Shane Finney, Tad Thayer and Gary Pierce were the top five scorers for Coldwater, with Gleason, Licht and Finney keying the win over Marshall.

Gleason led the entire distance around Marshall's abbreviated course, crossing the finish line in 15 minutes, 34 seconds and Licht finished a strong second at 15:47. Marshall took the next two positions, but Fin-

ney fought off challenges from two other Redskins to take fifth and ensure the Cardinal win.

A race expected to be as close as the boys' race was the Lady Cards' contest with both Marshall and Lakeview, but Coldwater posted identical 25-34 wins over each team.

The top three girls from each school did divide up the first nine places evenly, but it was Coldwater's pack of Michelle Laughry, Mary Nowak, Tammy Huntley and Cynthia Grupp in 10th through 13th places that decided the race.

Jill Strawser paced the Lady Cards, who are honorable mention in Class B, with a second-place time of 18:35. Dawn Valle was fifth at 19:18 and Joan Monroe finished seventh.

The Lady Cards, 3-0 in the Twin Valley and the boys, 2-1 in the conference and 5-2 overall, will both run Saturday in the annual Charger Invitational at Union City.
