Coldwater cross country

HASTINGS — Coldwater High's cross country teams continued on the winning path, albeit a wet one here Wednesday as both the girls' and boys' teams gained victories over Hastings and Albion on Hastings' water-logged course.

The Lady Cards cruised to a 15-50 win over Hastings and won by forfeit over Albion when the Wildcats failed to finish five runners.

Jill Strawser, Dawn Valle, Joan Monroe and Robin Brodt took the first four places for Coldwater, with Strawser winning in 19:53. Valle was

clocked in 19:57, Monroe at 21:28 and Brodt at 21:31. Michelle Laughry finished sixth at 22:07.

The double victory kept the third-ranked Lady Cards in first place in the Twin Valley with a 4-0 record and upped their season mark to 7-1.

The boys improved to 7-2 on the season with a 15-49 rout of Albion and a 25-30 win over the Saxons.

Hastings All-Stater Wayne Oom pulled away from Coldwater's Shane Finney in the last mile to win in 16:28. Finney crossed the finish line in 17:08. He was followed by teammates Brian Licht (17:25) and Tad Thayer (17:40).

Saxons runners finished fifth, seventh, eighth and ninth to make the score close, but Pat Angle's sixth place and Jim Barnes coming in 10th gave the win to the Cardinals, now 3-1 and in second place in the league.

Both Coldwater teams will compete in the Charger Invitational Saturday at Union City.
