The next four finishers also won widely and work personal best with the control of the control o

Quincy and Tammy Huntley (21:25) of Coldwater.

In the boys' race, Coldwater was simply overpowering. The Cardinals took the first five places and seven of the top eight spots. Only Bronson's Darrell Vorce was able to break Coldwater's stranglehold on the top spots
