GENERAL INFORMATION

1. OFFICIALS - The Officials' Tent will be located near the south end of the football field.
2. REGISTRATION - Coaches should pick up their packet near the Concession Stand. Contestants' numbers, pins, programs and heat and lane assignments will be issued. Coaches must make sure their contestants wear assigned numbers.
- *3. TEAMS WITH RELAYS - Relay cards are enclosed in the coaches packet. It is the coaches responsibility to record name, number, and school on the relay cards to be presented to the Clerk of Course.
4. DRESSING ROOM - Two dressing rooms will be available for contestants. The girls will use #1 and the boys will use #2 locker rooms which are located under the stadium. Schools should use their own towels. Valuables should be checked with your coach or some other reliable person.
5. MEALS - Schools are responsible for their own meals. Meals will be served in the cafeteria of Northwestern Community High School starting at 11:00 a.m.
6. CONTESTANT SEATING AREA - All contestants must sit in the designated area as shown on enclosed map. This area will be in the N.W. section of the stands.
7. BULL PEN - The bull pen will be located at the northwest end of the Stadium. All contestants should report to the Clerk of Course in this area.
8. TRAINING - A trainer will be available in the bull pen area.
9. WARM UP - The warm up area will be on the west side of the Stadium in the Driver Training Area. Contestants should be warmed up and ready to compete at the scheduled time.
10. TIME SCHEDULE - A time schedule has been included for your convenience.
11. TRACK EVENTS - All track events of 400 meters or more will be run in front of the stands. The 100 meter dash, 100 meter low hurdles and 110 meter high hurdles will be run in front of the stands. The 200 meter dash will start on the opposite side of the track with staggered starts and finish in front of the stands. The 300 meter low hurdles will start on the opposite side of the track and finish in front of the stands.
12. FIELD EVENTS - All Field Events will be held in the areas indicated on your enclosed map.
13. HEAT QUALIFIERS - The selection of qualifiers to the Semis and Finals of the Dashes and Hurdles will be by place finishes in preliminary heats and the time for the 5th place winners as indicated on the heat sheet.
14. SCRATCHES - Prelim scratches must be made to Mary LaVoie by 9:00 a.m. at the concession stand. Final scratches must be made to Mary LaVoie by 12 noon at the concession stand. All contestants entered in an event must compete in that event, or the contestant will be disqualified for the remainder of the meet.
15. TIMING - Fully automatic times will be used to record the official times and determine places. Manual times and the manual selection of place winners will be utilized only when there is a malfunction of the fully automatic timing system.

ATTENTION COACHES

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

NOTE: All finals will be run in order and as fast as possible. There will be no delays for runners in the finals.

All contestants will remain in the stands until 1st call is made whereby they will be allowed to enter the bull pen.

All Prelim scratches must be made to Mary LaVoie at the concession stand by 9:00 a.m. Final scratches must be made to Mary LaVoie at the concession stand by 12 noon.

Your cooperation is requested to keep contestants and spectators in their proper places as outlined below. Please discuss these items with your team:

1. All track shoes MUST HAVE $\frac{1}{4}$ " SPIKES OR LESS in order to run on the all-weather track. Track athletes who do not follow this rule WILL NOT be allowed to participate in the track meet.
2. Gill starting blocks will be available for use. No individual school starting blocks will be permitted on the track.
3. Contestants and coaches should stay in the northwest section of the stands as designated.
4. Please ask your athletes to stay away from officials at the finish line.
5. Each team is expected to furnish its own equipment in all field events.
6. Rules governing the State Meet are set forth in the 1986 Track and Field Rule Book and the Michigan State Athletic Department Bulletin of March, 1986.
7. Please warm up 15 minutes prior to the time indicated in the track and field events.
8. NO EVENT will be held up for contestants not at the starting post.
9. We would appreciate all coaches staying with their team and keeping them in the designated seat area.
10. There will be no SUBSTITUTIONS for athletes qualifying from the Regional Entry Form except as allowed in the relay events.

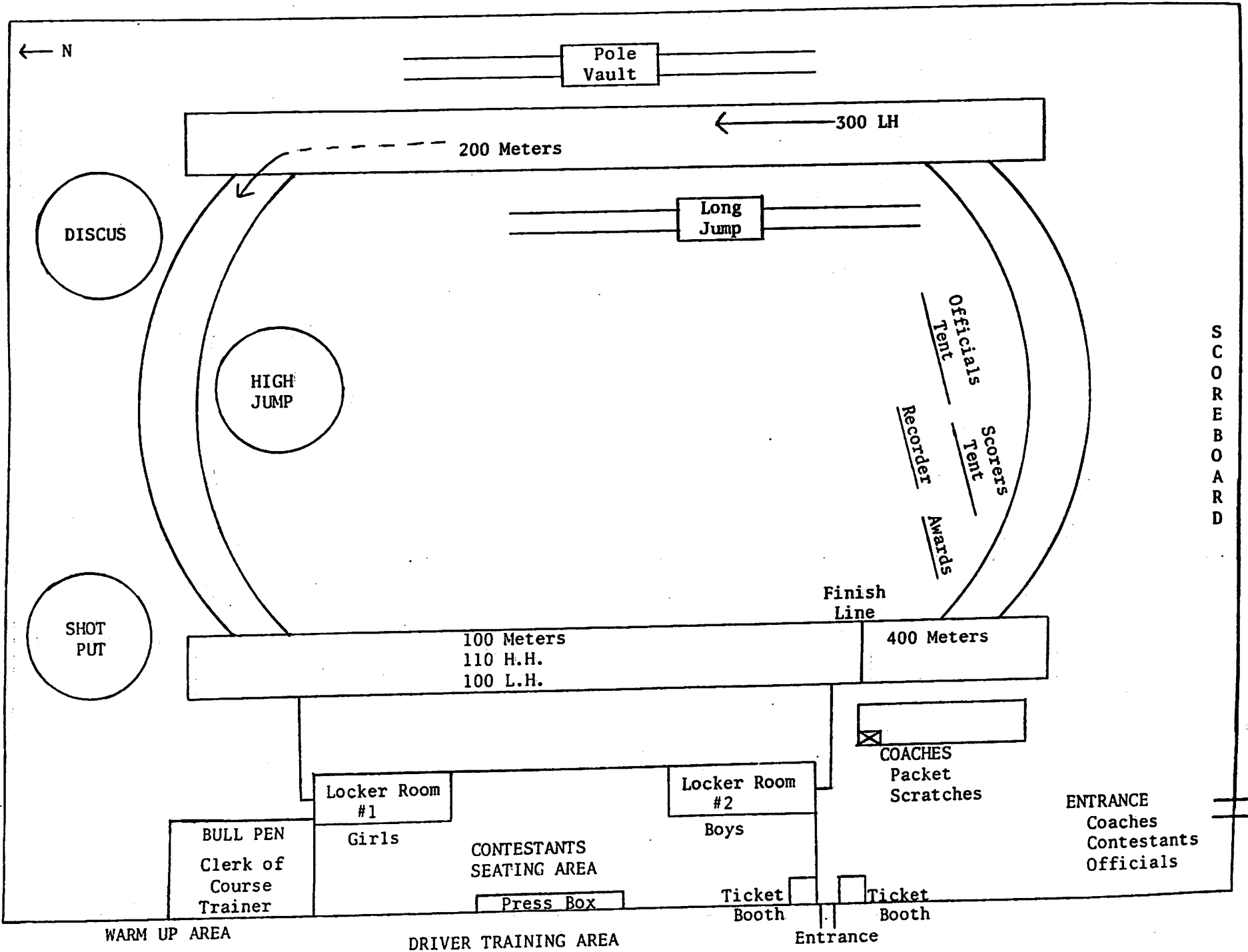
