THE TWENTY-NINTH ANNUAL MITCA TRACK CLINIC

The Lansing Hilton Friday & Saturday, Jan. 9-10, 1987

President Bill Swanwick was the architect of this annual clinic & meeting. This was a full two day affair, starting with registration at 8:00 A.M., on Friday. Bob Parks, track and cross country coach at Eastern Michigan University, spoke on "Coaching the Middle Distance Runner".

Berny Wagner spoke on the "National Track and Field Hall of Fame". "Innovations in the Shot and Discus" were discussed Jim Santos. Berny Wagner is from the TAC (The Athletics Congress) and Jim Santos is Director of Track and Field, Special Olympics, Inc.

The coaches were on their own for lunch and movies of the 1986 Midwest Meet of Champions was shown during this time.

A full five hour session on "Chemical Awareness and Athletics" under the direction of Hazelden-Cork, a sports education program, with headquarters in Minnesota, consumed the afternoon portion of the clinic.

The Coach of the Year Banquet was held in the evening with Jim Santos as an after dinner speaker. The 1986 Track Coach of the Year Awards were presented, along with several other special awards.

The first order of business on Saturday morning was the Prediction Fun Run. A resume of the results will follow in another portion of this letter.

Bob Graduated from Mt. Morris High School and attended Western Michigan Uni. From 1943 to 1946 he was on Military Service with the U. S. Army. He obtained a B.A. from Eastern Michigan Uni. in 1953 and a M.A. from Eastern in 1960.

He coached and taught at Sturgis High School from 1951 to 1953. The next four years were spent at General Motors.

Bloomer, after leaving General Motors, taught and coached track and cross country at Howell High School, where he produced two State Champion cross country teams. (1958 & 1959). He coached Eric Zemper to the State Mile Championship.

From 1964 to 1970, he was the track and cross country coach at Flint Northwestern, where he produced outstanding high jumpers, hurdlers, 880 runners and sizzling relay teams. Flint Northwestern was listed in the top five listing on five different years.

Bob was the Athletic Director at Holly high School from 1970 to 1974. He is still teaching at Holly and spends his spare time as a cross country and track official.

He was the meet manager of the first girls' Track State Championships at Brighton and also two cross country State Championships hosted by Brighton. He has managed many Regional and League championship meets.

Mr. Bloomer is a very excellent starter for track and cross country and one of the best in the State. He has been the starter at the Huron Relays at Eastern Michigan Uni. for many years, as well as the Ambrose-Eccentric Relays, the All-Oakland County X. C. Championships, the MITCA indoor meets, the West Bloomfield Invitationals, the Holly Invite, Detroit Catholic League Championships, plus many other league and invitational meets.

Bob is a MITCA past-president (1971) and is working very diligently with MITCA and the MHSAA to form an association of registered track officials with the sole purpose of developing a better working knowledge of the rules and their enforcement in track and field.

Mr. Bloomer lives with his wife Betty in Fenton. They have four children, one boy and three girls.

Bob is an avid bass fisherman and belongs to the Michigan Bass Fishermans' Asso. He was a former newsletter writer for this asso.

Congratulations on this honor and we look forward to seeing you at many of the cross country and track and field meets.

I think it makes a big difference to the runners and it makes a difference to me. Just because it seems to be a little thing, let me inform you that it's a lot of little things that make up the big and final picture. I feel that I have been fairly successful in all of the things that I have been involved with over the years. I don't think that I am careless and sloppy, when I start a track meet or a cross country run, write a MITCA Newsletter, manage track and cross country meets, manage my cross country camp, and all of the years I coached football, basketball, cross country and track. Plus setting up cross courses, putting in starting lines and putting up chutes for hundreds of meets over the years. Like I have said on many occasions, "no matter how old you get, you can always learn something new". Furthermore, I feel that everything I know, I have learned from other people.
