Athens eyes 3rd state track title

After Litchfield edged out Athens for the Class D Regional airls' track title two weeks ago, some thought that was a signal the Indians may be ready to give up their state title.

But Athens Coach Walt Schalau says don't count out his two-time de-fending state champions just yet.

"I think (our) chances are pretty decent," said Schalau of Athens winning a third straight title. "It just depends on how well we run."

Athens will find out Saturday at the Class D state meet at Traverse City High. Field events begin at 10 a.m., with running event finals at 1:30 p.m.

Numerous other area athletes will be competing Saturday at the Class B and Class C state meets at Sturgis High and Bangor High, respectively. Field events for both meets begin at 10 a.m., with running event finals at 1:30 p.m.

Athens will be taking a team of 12 runners to the Class D state meet. five of whom have been on the last two title teams. They are seniors Angie Brown, Tina Kinney, Doreen Kinney, Sarah Knowles and sophomore Jeri Reed. Others who have been to the state meet but not competed are senior Missy Fast and juniors Joani Riddle and Shannon Flemming.

"Eight have the experience of being there before, and that's a big

plus," Schalau said.

Freshmen Cindy Troxel, Amy Miller, Danie Barton and Amy Bottomly also will compete for the Indians.

Athens has people competing in eight of 12 individual events and have all four relays competing

Brown and Tina Kinney will compete in the long jump, with Brown also in the 200. Doreen Kinney and Bottomly will compete in the discus, with Flemming in the shot put. Knowles will be in the 3200, Fast in the 100 hurdles, Troxel in the 300 hurdles and Miller the 100.

Knowles will team will Riddle, Reed and Barton in the 3200 relay, while Miller Troxel, Tina Kinney and Reed will team in the 1600 relay. Brown, Troxel, Miller and Tina Kinney will team in both the 400 and 800 relays.

"I think everyone we've got going has a good chance to place, but I just don't know how high," Schalau said.

Athens' main threats to the title are regional champion Litchfield, Big Eight (East) foe Concord, Fowler and Akron-Fairgrove.

"It's going to be interesting," Schalau said.

Concord Coach Chuck King feels, though, Athens and Litchfield are the teams to beat come Saturday.

"I think it's (meet) going to be well balanced," King said. "Litchfield and Athens are extremely good in the field events."

Competing for Concord are Angela Salvatore in the high jump and 300 hurdles, Debbie Raymond in the 100 and 200 and Rena Bradner in the 400. Concord also qualified its 400, 800 and 1600 relay teams.

Like every coach, King said how well Concord runs will determine its standing in the state meet.

"It will all come down to who does it on this particular day," King said.

Litchfield is led by Amy Griffiths, who will compete in the discus, shot put and long jump.

Michelle Payne will compete in the 1600 and 3200 runs, while Deb Vargo is in the 100, Susan Warren in the 100 hurdles and Mindi Pate in the 800.

The Terriers also have their 400, 1600 and 3200 relays qualified.
