

Athens and Warren tied for eighth with three.

**Track:** Grosse Pointe North's **Mike Wujek** won the long jump (6-3), was third in the high jump (19-41/4), fourth in the 400-meter run (50.9 seconds) and third in the 100-meter run (11.3) at the Class A regional track and field meet at Grosse Pointe South.

"He was our workhorse," said Norsemen coach Bob Collins.

North finished with 105 points to hold off Warren De La Salle (88) and Detroit Denby (81).

After four events in the boys meet, North had a 20-point lead over De La Salle. Mark DeManigold won the discus (152-11) for North. The Pilots won the 400-(44.2) and 3,200-meter relays (8:02.9) and Paul De Lave won the 3,200-meter run (9:51.9).

However, North's **Adrian Weyhing** (9:55.6) and **Tom Rice** (10:01.4) took the next two places to clinch the meet for North.

Denby sophomore Mary Blackmon won the one-mile (5:30.0) and two-mile (12:17.9), as the Lady Tars won their second straight Class A-regional with 99 points, followed by Osborn (84) and Grosse Pointe South (68).

"She came through in the big meet," Tars coach Rubin Washington said of Blackmon's efforts.

Denby won the 800 (1:44.6) and 1,600 relays (3:59) and the Tars' **Delesiah Partee** took the discus (115-2) and **Dawn McFarlin** the 400 meters (58.0).
