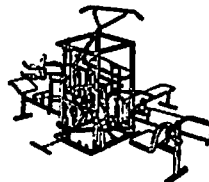
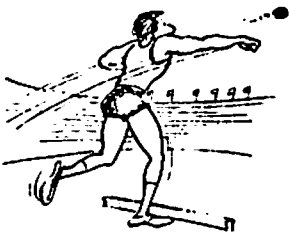
"Any athlete knows what it takes to get back, but there always are doubts — months of wondering if you can get in shape and take a hit. But I used reverse psychology: telling myself I'm going to get better but I have to be patient.
