



# Saline finish is highest ever

**YPSILANTI** — Saline tied Sturgis for fourth place in the Class B championships Saturday at Eastern Michigan University.

Coach Don DiPaolo led the Hornets (16 points) to their highest finish ever.

Although the three Hornets who advanced to Saturday's singles semifinals did not win, they got there by posting upset wins Friday over opponents who were ranked higher.

Cranbrook claimed the team title with 27 points. It was the school's ninth Class B state championship, and Coach Dan Brown was doused with a bucket of ice water by his charges in celebration.

Brown said playing in the 90-degree heat at Eastern Michigan did not have an adverse effect on his team.

"I'm just happy that it didn't rain," Brown said after his team swept the doubles competition.

## CLASS B

Last year, the Cranes were runners-up in the state, losing to Okemos. But since Okemos moved up to Class A, Cranbrook became the defending champion.

Saline fought hard, but could not improve upon its fourth-place standing from Friday's competition.

Hornet Derek Shaefer at second singles put up the hardest fight for entry into the finals, but lost to Gary Koch of St. Joseph, 6-7, 6-2, 6-2 (7-2). Koch eventually lost to the winner, Mason's Mike Eberly, 6-3, 6-0.

In first singles action, Saline's Rob Spears lost to powerhouse top seed Brad Dancer of Mason, 6-2, 6-1. Dancer went on to win first singles, defeating Adam Kraft, 6-0, 6-3.

Second-ranked Kent Morrison from Saline also succumbed, but to

third-ranked Raul Govila of Cranbrook, 6-2, 6-4. Govila was eventually beaten by top seed Steve Markward of East Grand Rapids in a close match, 7-5, 6-4.

"Schaefer tried the first set," said DiPaolo, "but when the adrenaline wore off, the other guy's talent overpowered him. But it was a gutsy tournament."

DiPaolo said he wouldn't have believed five years ago that his team could have finished in the top four, or that the state tournament could have been co-played at Saline.

Original plans to have Saline and Ypsilanti High co-host the tournament were scratched two days ago after it was discovered that Ypsilanti's courts had cracks.

"It's really gratifying," DiPaolo said. "It's been a dream season."

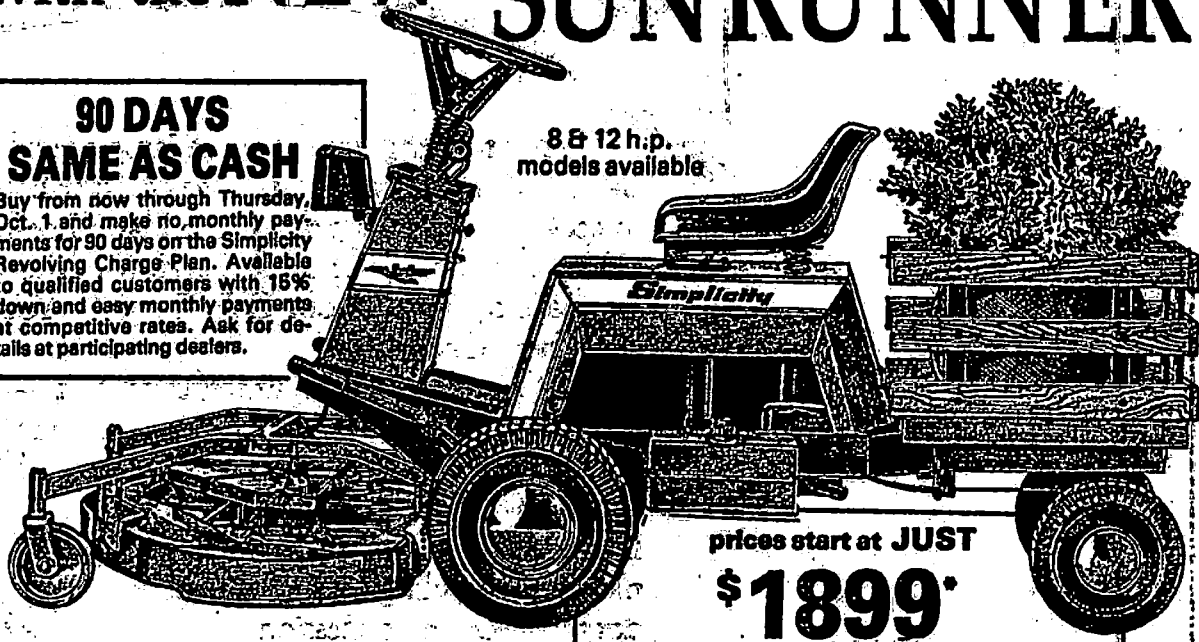
"Cranbrook had lots of talent — they're state champion for a reason," he concluded. "But all the teams that won today are losing players except for us. I feel good about next year."

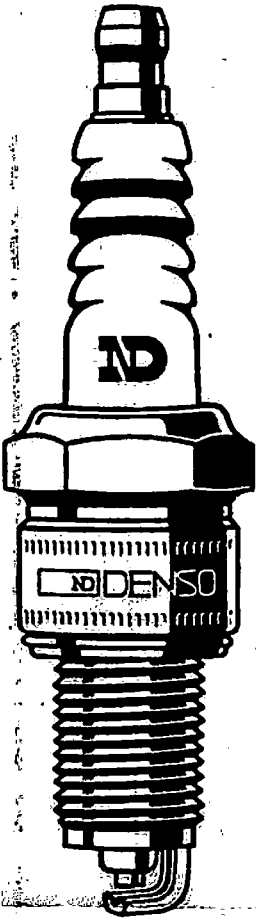
