Lancer girls claim track crown

There's a new queen on the Lakeland Conference track throne.

Lakeshore's girls ended Cassopolis' five-year reign as league champions by capturing four firsts on their way to scoring 128 points in the league meet on the Lancers' new all-weather metric track. Buchanan was second with 104 and Cassopolis third with 90.

Cassopolis' girls had won four straight Lakeland Blue Division crowns and last year's combined league title. Lakeshore had won all five Red Division titles, but lost five Cassopolis last year when the two divisions combined.

Lancer girls also finished first in league dual meets, posting an 8-0 record to win the overall title, as did Edwardsburg's boys, who ran away with the league meet. It was Edwardsburg's fifth straight conference track crown.

"The girls have run well all year," said Lakeshore girls coach Dennis Brueck. "Depth has done it for us throughout the season, and it paid off again tonight." The Lancer girls were unbeaten (11-0) in dual meets this season and placed a strong third in last Saturday's Class B regional.

Lakeshore girls have now won every conference championship this school year with the exception of cross country. The Lancers' track title was another jewel in their all-league sports crown along with softball, basketball and volleyball league titles.

The Eddie boys of co-coaches Terry Gizzi and Don Bourdon captured six firsts in scoring 156 points to run up Lakeshore's 113½.

Edwardsburg had a pair of triple winners in hurdler Brett Hoover and Kris Hinton. Hoover took both hurdle events, setting a new meet record of 15.1 in the 110 highs and was a member of the Eddies' winning 800 relay squad along with Hinton, Jeff Milliken and Norm

Barlow. Hinton also won the 400 dash and anchored the winning 1600 relay unit, which also contained Milliken and Barlow.

Dowagiac sprint star Tamott Wolverson was another triple winner, taking both dashes and anchoring the Chiefs' winning 400 relay team which set a new meet record of 44.1. Wolverson's 10.9 clocking in 100 meters tied a meet record. Other members of the Chiefs' 400 unit were Greg Baker, Rob O'Brien and Aaron Murray.

River Valley's Dave Hahn won the 800 and 1600 runs, setting a new meet record of 1:57.9 in the 800. Cassopolis' sprint star Deb Edwards was the meet's only quadruple winner as she won both the 100 and 200 dashes, set a new meet record by going 17-1 in the long jump and anchored the Rangers' winning 400 relay unit.

Lakeshore's top individual performer was standout hurdler Carey Buczwinski. The slender senior took both the 100 and 300 hurdles and anchored the Lancers' winning 1600 relay team, which included Cheryl Petzke, Heidi Hild and Julie Aviles.

Coloma's Alison Fournier won the shot put and discus, setting a new meet record of 117-0 in the discus.

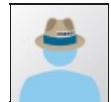
