

AATC athletes shine at meets

DIGEST Local girls from the Ann Arbor Track Club have done well in the past two weeks. Crystal Braddock competed in the World Junior Championships in Tallahassee, Fla. Running against top athletes age 20-under, she made the semifinals of the 100 and 200 meters with times of 12.20 and 24.73.

In Indianapolis two weekends ago, Seana Arnold ran the second fastest 3,200 ever by a Michigan prep, 10:41.16.

At the TAC age group meet in Detroit, 37 locals placed in the top three. Sheila Rowry led the high school girls with a first in the 100 meters in 14.88.
