# Cards sweep past Brooklyn Columbia

**BROOKLYN** — Coach Jim Billsborow's Coldwater Cards' boys and girls cross country teams both improved to 5-0 in dual meets by posting non-conference victories over Brooklyn Columbia Central on Tuesday.

The Coldwater boys won by the score of 21-36, as the Cards' Bob Bates was the medal winner with a three-mile record-course time of 17:46 at Brooklyn Columbia's new course.

Coldwater's Eric Rueppel took third with a time of 19:01, while the Cards' Terry Huntley was fourth at 19:19 and Ted Turner, fifth at 19:35. Coldwater's Mike Sims took eighth place with a time of 21:05.

In the girl's competition, Coldwater's Jill Strawser set a course record with a time of 22:12 to take home medal winner honors, as the Lady Cards earned a 23-32 victory.

**THE CARDS' JOY** Strawser was second at 22:36, while Coldwater's Danielle Lippert was fifth (23:45); Jill Thayer, seventh (24:49) and Joan Monroe, eighth (24:54).

Coldwater travels to Harper Creek on Wednesday to take on the Beavers.

**Bronson at Maple Valley BATTLE CREEK** — Bronson swept past Maple Valley in a Southern Michigan Athletic Association cross country meet on Tuesday.

The Lady Vikings posted a 21-34

decision over the Lions to improve their record to a spotless 3-0 on the season (also 3-0 SMAA).

Bronson's Nichole Hutchins was the medal winner with a time of 21:56, while the Lady Vikes' Dodie Willer took second at 22:10. Bronson's Tanya Skaggs was fifth at 23:50; Heather Badgley, sixth at 23:56 and Jessica Grindle, seventh at 25:18.

**IN THE BOY'S** competition, Bronson posted a convincing 16-46 victory, as the Vikings' A.J. Hoard was the medal winner with a time of 20:07.

Bronson's Jamie Grove was second at 20:09, while the Vikings' Mike Roberts was third with a time of 20:58. Mike Scott was fourth at 21:01; Mitch Burch, sixth at 21:52; Mark Skinner, seventh at 21:57; Kris Hurley, ninth at 22:52 and Tony Snyder, 10th at 22:55.

The Bronson Vikings' boys team is also 3-0 overall and in the SMAA.

Bronson returns to action on Thursday, when the Vikings travel to Union City to take on the Chargers in a non-conference meet.

**QUINCY** — Coach Marty Chard's Quincy Lady Orioles improved their record to a spotless 4-0 overall and 2-0 in the Big Eight Conference with a 23-35 league victory over Jonesville on Tuesday.

**QUINCY'S SHASTA** McClughen was the medal winner with a time of 22:40, while the Lady Orioles' Loretta Tobolske took second with a time of 23:03. Jill Clark was fifth at 23:41; Angie Cook, seventh at 24:13 and Linda Kurtz, eighth at 24:30.

The Orioles' boys team dropped a 25-31 decision to the Comets, as their record falls to 0-4 overall and 0-2 in the league.

Quincy's Don Banker took second with a time of 19:22, while Max Yarbrow was fifth at 20:24; Shane Russell, seventh at 20:40; Jeff Erts, eighth at 20:42 and Shawn Cockrell, ninth at 20:48.

Quincy will return to action on Thursday, Sept. 29, when the Orioles will host Hanover-Horton at 4 p.m.
