Lady Cards post exciting track win

STURGIS — Coach Bob Mullally's Coldwater Lady Cards drastically improved their chances for a second consecutive Twin Valley Conference track title with an impressive 66-62 come-from-behind victory over the always tough Sturgis Trojans on Tuesday.

With the victory, the Lady Cards are now a spotless 3-0 overall and 2-0 in the league.

On Saturday, the Lady Cards took fourth-place in the Sturgis Exchange Club Relays while Sturgis won the event.

In Tuesday's thriller, Coldwater's Jill Strawser claimed top honors in the 3200-meter run (12:36.2), 1600-meter run (5:47.9) and 800-meter run (2:33.8), while the Lady Cards' Joy Strawser was also victorious in three events by winning the 400-meter dash (62.0), 200-meter dash (27.3) and 100-meter dash (13.4).

COLDWATER'S SHELLY WINNIE captured top honors in the shot put (31-8) and discus (101-0), while the Lady Cards' Dawn Marriott won the 100-meter high hurdles (17.3) and the 300-meter low hurdles with a time of 49.8.

The Lady Cards' Jill Monroe, Joan Monroe, Dawn Marriott and Joy Strawser teamed up to win the 3200-meter relay with a time of 10:18.7.

In the boys' competition, Sturgis posted a 110-27 victory over the Cards. Coldwater's Andy Schorfhaar won the pole vault at 11-6, while the Cards' Rob Porter took top honors in the 100-meter dash with a time of 11.7. Chad Broughman won the 400-meter dash for the Cards with a time of 54.9.

Coldwater will return to action on Thursday, as the Cards will travel to Hillsdale to take on the Hornets at 4:30 p.m.
