Owosso's **Toby Van Pett** vaulted 14 feet, 10 inches to win the pole vault at the Class A Midland meet and Saginaw's **Curtis Sumfer** won the 800-meter run in 1:56.1.

Joel Thomason won the shot put with a heave of 53 feet, 1% inches at the Class A Port Huron Northern meet.

Troy's 3,200-meter relay team of Mrt Desai, Ramsey Wilson, Alex Ramos and Ed Andrews won in 7:59.2 at West Bloomfield's Class A meet, while Utica Ford's Bill Stricklen won the 3,200-meter run in 9:27.2.
