Algonac: Host with the most

Algonac had a record-breaking day Saturday. The team hosted and won a Class B regional with 104 points and broke six school records in the process.

Senior **Raquel Tuma** won the 100-meter hurdles in 15.02 seconds, breaking the record of 15.1. Senior **Denise Granica** took second in the 100-meter dash in 12.43, a school record. Granica, who has broken the record three times this season, held the old mark of 12.6.

Algonac set school records in winning all four relays. It won the 3,200-meter relay in 10:08.5; the 800-meter relay in 1:47.0; the 400-meter relay in 52.58; and the 1,600-meter in 4:13.8.

"Every girl but one ran a personal best," Algonac Coach **Dan Shafer** said. "We did exceptionally well. We just want to get as many medals as we can at the state Class B meet."

The state meet is June 3 in Jackson.
