

Cody boys, girls outdistance field at PSL West meet

A new start for Cody coach Ben Purkett has meant new life for the Comets' girls track team. Last year, the Cody team had just seven athletes. Now 15 members strong — including senior 300-meter low hurdle champion Dawn Adams, who transferred from Cooley when Purkett moved to Cody — the Comets are West division champions.

The Cody girls and boys teams won championships Monday at Lorenzo Wright Field at Martin Luther King High.

The girls won with 125 points followed by defending champior Cooley with 83, Mumford (64) Henry Ford (60), Mackenzie (47) Southwestern (39), Chadsey (16) and Padford (13)

The boys scored 131 points followed by defending champion Mumford with 104, Cooley (96) Northwestern (66), Chadsey (26) Renaissance (11), Southwestern (10) and Western (4). All time and scores are unofficial because of a computer breakdown.

The top four individuals in each event and the top six in the distance events (half-mile, mile and two mile) qualify for the PSL Championship, 2 p.m. May 23, at Wright Field.

As Purkett kept a watchful eye on his team, he couldn't help but cheer on his son, Anthony, a Cooley senior. Purkett, 49, the dean of students at Cody, left Cooley after three seasons because of administrative cutbacks.

Anthony Purkett won the 100 meter dash in 11.19 seconds and ran the first leg of the winning 400 relay (43.61) with senior Williams and sonhomore Marco West.

"He's been impressive today," the elder Purket said, "If would be great if we could put it out today, Jast cambe here and tried to put together a program. You can't sit back and make kids come to you. I wanted them to eat right and sleep right, and we've got them dressed right in new uniforms. They deserve this. You have to make if fun for them. If we came here and didn't win the West side championship, I would be dissensorited?

Adams has been a big part of the Cody turnaround. Headed to college at Iowa, Adams won he second straight 300 hurdle title (44.58), the 100 high hurdle (14.87) and anchored the winning mile relay (4:06.52), taking the baton with Cody in third place.
