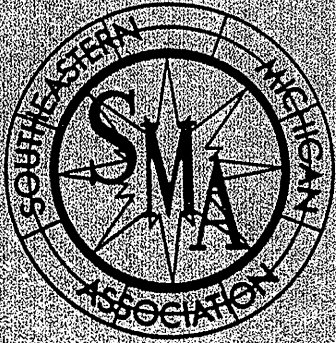

The summary booklets of most every track team across the state this year will begin something like ... "What a year, we've been dealt some lousy cards with weather, but this is the absolute worst." So here I go.


We registered over 100 students for boys track this year, and 51 receive awards. Most of those 51 put up with some real lousy weather conditions (some conveniently avoided the weather) and the over 49 that didn't stick it out think they are the smart ones! Maybe so. This booklet outlines objective achievements of our award winners, but their subjective achievements will remain cloaked until a time comes when the life-skills learned from participation in track & field will become useful.

THE SOUTHEASTERN MICHIGAN ASSOCIATION
