St. Joe thinclads take firsts at indoor meet

SOUTH BEND - St. Joseph thinclads took two firsts while finishing fourth among 15 teams in the South Bend Classic indoor track and field meet here Monday night.

St. Joe finished with 59 1/2 points in the meet at Notre Dame's Joyce Athletic & Convocation Center. Northwood took the title with 77 points, while Sturgis had 74 and Wawasee 66.

St. Joe coach Ron Waldvogel was happy with the finish, seeing that none of the Bears were in more than one running event. "We probably could have made a run at winning it," stated Waldvogel, "but nobody doubled up. I wanted to see how the young ones would compete."

Probably St. Joe's most impressive win was by Pete McDowell in the two-mile run. He won by almost half a minute with a time of 9:57.90.

The other St. Joe first was by Brian Kubicki in the shot put with Harbor, Dowagiac and Niles. a heave of 49 feet, 6 3/4 inches.

The Bears also got a second from Brent Lignell in the long jump (20-6) and a second from the medley relay team of Scott Soorus, Chad Kessman, Brad Wick and Tony Perron in 7:55.0.

Perron's anchor run marked his return to competition after missing most of the past year with a stress fracture.

"I am quite pleased with the way we are looking," concluded Waldvogel.

Three other southwestern Michigan teams competed in the meet.
