

MIDLAND DOW'S girls scored 109 points to easily win the 18th annual Flushing Invitational, which had the largest field in history. Fenton had 56 to finish third, the best by a Flint-area team. Grand Blanc's Gwen Wentland was the top area performer, winning the long jump and high jump while finishing second in the 300 hurdles.
