Flint teams stumble in Mott Relays



Flint's entries were far better hosts than contestants Friday in the 22nd annual Mott Relays.

They not only didn't get a championship, they had their worst overall performance since the meet began in 1969.

Northern High's boys finished fourth, missing third place because of a disqualification, but were far behind champion Traverse City's 70 points. The Vikings totaled 40 behind Ann Arbor Huron's 53 and Kalamazoo Loy Norrix's 44.

Northern's girls were a distant sixth with 22 points as five-time state champion Ann Arbor Pio-Please see MOTT — C5

neer claimed its second Mott title in three years with 74 points.

Rain and wind swept Houston Stadium, preventing any chances for records.

"I've been here when snowed, but it wasn't this bad," said veteran Beecher Coach Martin Crane, who has had his team in all 22 meets.

Traverse City, which should be accustomed to shaky spring weather, ran into the unexpected.

However, he was happy to gather in an armload of trophies, also taking home the runner-up honors for girls.

Northern claimed Flint's only victories among 25 events.

The foursome of David Burton, Marvin Allen, Akil Young and Roeman Williams sprinted the Mott 4x200 in 1:30.8 for a convincing 4.1-seconds edge over runner-up Beecher.

Allen returned with Ettien Rodgers, Charrod Richmond and Nate Tedford to win the 4x400 relay in 3:33.12. Again the winning margin of three seconds was comfortable.

The Vikings also were second in the spring medley relay but another second place was denied by a disqualification in the 4x100 re-lay. The DQ cost eight points which would have pushed them into third place.

Central tied for eighth place with 16 points, partly because of an injury which limited Chris Oli-

ver to one race.

The Indians' best finishes were thirds in the sprint medley

relay and high jump.

Northern's girls were second in the 4x200 relay for their best effort. Central, which finished one point behind in seventh place, had seconds in the high jump and shot put.

Southwestern Academy was ninth among the girls with 12 points but last in the 14-team boys' division with four points.

Northwestern was I lth among 13 girls' teams with two points and 13th among the boys with six points.

Ann Årbor Pioneer won seven of 12 girls' events, easily out-pointing Traverse City.
