**BASEBALL:**

The boys' team won in a scrimmage against Mumford on March 11 under the coaching of William Sanford and Kerry Adams. Adams said, "Our goal is to make it to the playoffs."

**TRACK:**

**Boys** — Marco West ran the 55-meter dash in 6.41 seconds for the boys track club. West ran the same event in 6.21 which was his best time in the year and the second best time in the state. According to Gene Ballard, "The time can't get much faster than that."

Other runners and their times are Robert Adams, 300-meter dash in 35.7; David Norman, 600-meter run in 1:24.65; Robert Johnson, 55-meter high hurdles in 7.9; and the 4x 400-meter relay team, Robert Adams, Raphael Johnson, David Norman, and Marco West who ran in 3:27.29 seconds.

The runners competed at the University of Michigan for the Michigan Track Coaches' Association Indoor Championship. The mile relay team (4x 400 ) won the state championship with a time of 3:25:7. Robert Adams also won first place at the state championship in the 300 yard dash in a time of 32.10 seconds.

At Jenison Field House on the campus of Michigan State University, the track club qualified runners for the state championship in the 600-meter run, 300-meter dash, 55-meter dash, 55-meter high hurdles and the 4x 400-meter relay.

**Girls** — At a recent meet in East Lansing, the girls track club qualified for the state championship. Qualifiers were Tanae Moore in the 60-meter, Tenisha Gilbert and Carmalita Staley in the 300-meter and the 800 and 1600-meter relay consisting of Kareema Durden, Gilbert, Moore and Staley.

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
