EASTERN MICHIGAN UNIVERSITY HAS A GREAT TRACK TRADITION

Eastern Michigan has had a great track tradition through the years. Even before World War I the school had a good track program and it has continued ever since. Only three men have ever coached the Hurons in this sport. Dr. L. W. Olds, an Olympic Coach in 1932 and 1948, coached from 1916-1942; George Marshall coached from 1943-1967 and current coach Bob Parks has headed the program since 1967.

Eastern has had two Olympic Champions and two Bronze Medalists. Hayes Jones took the Bronze in 1960 and the Gold in 1964 in the 110 meter high hurdles while Hasely Crawford won the Gold in 1976 in the 100 meter dash and Earl Jones took the Bronze in 1984 in the 800 meter run. Crawford participated in four Olympiads. Other EMU Olympians were Dave Ellis in 1968 in the 5000 and 10000 meter runs and Tony Nelson in 1972 in the 110 meter high hurdles.

In there 18 years in the Mid-American Conference the Green and White has won 11 track titles and 4 cross country crowns. They have also won the past 8 Outdoor Central Collegiate Championships (midwest meet) and have been as high as 4th in track and 6th in cross country in NCAA Division I national competition.

Prior to joining Division I Eastern won two NCAA Division II and seven NAIA national titles. A great many men have competed in international competition as well as the Olympic Sports Festival. Bob Parks was head coach of the USA team which competed against the British and Irish in Europe in 1987.

The Hurons have won 8 of the past 9 MAC titles in track and field. In 1989 they scored a record total of 201 points. Their closest margin of victory was 24 points. Twice the margin was almost 100 points. EMU has had hundreds of All-Americans and a huge number of conference and regional champions.

EMU Olympians Hayes Jones and Earl Jones (no relation to each other) have both competed in the Huron Relays. Hayes won the high hurdles in 1956 and Earl won the mile run in 1982. Both also ran some relay legs here in their career. Hayes ran for Pontiac Central while Earl competed for Taylor Center. Current EMU mentor, Bob Parks coached at Redfordd Thurston High School and his teams ran in the first six Huron Relays.

1991 EMU MEN'S TRACK & FIELD - SENIOR PROFILES

The Eastern Michigan University Men's Track and Field Team is paced by a number of Senior standouts.

MARK DAILEY from Lakewood, Ohio - St. Edward, placed 2nd in the 1990 NCAA Indoor 800 meters after placing 3rd the year before. He has an outdoor best of 1:46.77 for the 800 and 4:04.12 for the indoor mile. He won the MAC 800 indoors this year for the 4th straight year and the mile for the 3rd straight year. He will go after his 4th straight outdoor 800 title and 3rd straight 1500 meter title this spring.

CHUCK WILSON was a finalist in the NCAA Indoor 400 last winter and holds EMU varsity records in both indoors and outdoors with a best time of 45.95 and a relay split of 44.9. He has been MAC 400 Champion the past three years. He is a graduate of Detroit Benedictine High School.

MARK SMITH from Lansing Waverly is three time MAC pole vault Champion and has a best of 17'4 1/2" while JASON MASTERSON from Troy, won the 1990 indoor shot put and 35 lb. weight titles with bests of 55'11 1/2" and 61'8 1/2", both EMU records.

SCOTT HIPPEN from Cleveland, Ohio - Benedictine is MAC outdoor steeplechase and indoor 3000 meter Champion as well. He has run 3:47 (1500M), 4:06 (mile), 8:55 (5C) and 8:09 (3000M). BRIAN BENN from Barbados has long jumped 24'7" and won a MAC indoor title while BRIAN CHADWICK from Dearborn Divine Child was 1990 MAC Outdoor 400 Meter Hurdle runner-up at 51.47 and has a 46.8 relay split.

This elite group will have to be replaced in the near future. Hopefully the talented field in the 1991 Huron Relays will provide some of this help.

EASTERN MICHIGAN TRACK & FIELD COACHING STAFF

HEAD COACH, Bob Parks

Bob Parks takes over as Meet Director of the Huron Relays from the Legendary Kermit Ambrose. Parks has been Head Track and Cross Country Coach at Eastern since January of 1967. Before that he was Assistant Coach at Western Michigan University for 5 1/2 years and coached at Redford Thurston, Dewitt and Ferndale High Schools for a total of 9 years.

Parks is a graduate of Howell High School where he played football, basketball and baseball and was State Class B 440 Champion. At Eastern Michigan he was Track Captain, Conference 880 Champion and a member of the schools record setting mile relay team.

At Eastern he has coached numerous record-setters, All-Americans and championship teams. He has been MAC, CCC, and District NCAA Coach of the Year many times, but his highest honor was in 1990 when he was named NCAA Division I National Indoor Track and Field Coach of the Year.

ASSISTANT COACH, Fred LaPlante

Fred LaPlante is in his third year as Assistant Coach at EMU since coming back to his alma mater from USC where he was Head Women's Coach. He will be Meet Manager for the Huron Relays. At Eastern he coaches the sprinters, hurdlers, 400 and relays. Prior to coaching at USC, Fred coached at San Diego State and Columbia as well as a junior college and several high schools. He was PAC 10 Coach of the Year and has coached a number of Olympians and All-Americans. Coach Parks considers him the best hurdle coach in the country.

While an undergraduate at Eastern he was a fine cross country runner and an All-American 1500 meter man in track. He ran a 4:06 mile and a 1:51 800 meters in college and 1:49 after graduation.

GRADUATE ASSISTANT, Scott Parks

Scott Parks is in his first year as Graduate Assistant at EMU after two years in the same capacity at Iowa State University where he assisted with the NCAA Champion Cross Country Team. Prior to that he was Assistant coach at Ypsilanti High School for four years. In high school he ran 4:20 and 1:56 as well as cross country. He took 2nd in the 1982 Huron Relays Class A Mile behind Earl Jones. At EMU he coaches the throwers and weightmen.

SPECIAL ASSISTANT, John Vardigan

John Vardigan is in his 12th year as the coach of pole vaulters, decathletes and javelin throwers. A former Huron athlete in the same events he teaches at Willow Run, an Ypsilanti suburb. He has coached these 17 foot vaulters at EMU as well as a number of others in the 15 and 16 foot ranges. His vaulters are annually the best in the MAC.

THE HURON RELAYS

To sponsor a major High School Track Meet was the dream of Eastern Michigan University's first two track Coaches Dr. L. W. Olds and George Marshall. This dream became a reality in 1956 when the First Annual Huron Relays were held in the brand new Bowen Fieldhouse. Olds, by then the schools Director of Physical Education and Athletics, and Coach Marshall organized the first meet and conducted it for the first five years.

Unable to sponsor the meet because of conference rules, Eastern asked the Detroit News to take it over and the News was a sponsor for the next ten years with Bruce Waha as Meet Director. Waha, the track coach at Detroit Redford and later Howell, changed the format some and the meet grew under his guidance.

The News gave up it's sponsorship after the 1970 meet and the EMU Alumni Track Club with Bill Mays as President took over. Kermit Ambrose, the very successful former coach at Birmingham Seaholm was asked to take over and he accepted. For the next 20 years he guided the Huron Relays to its present position as one of the largest and we feel the best high school meet in the country. Under his leadership it prospered in its reputation as a well-organized classy event.

After his 80th birthday Kermit decided to retire as Relay Director as well as cutdown on his schedule of officiating. Kermit will never fully retire, but he certainly deserves a "slow down" if he so desires. Everyone wishes him the best as he turns into middle age (for most people it is the 40's and 50's - for Kermit it is the 80's and 90's).

Eastern Michigan Head Coach and Assistant Fred LaPlante have taken over the meet knowing full well that they have gigantic shoes to fill. They vow to do their bet to keep the meet at its present level of excellence. They plan to keep most of Kermit's system in place with a few minor improvements. The EMU Team and Alumni will help keep the meet rolling.

Olympic Champions Hayes Jones and Rex Cawley and Olympic place-winner Earl Jones all ran in the Huron Relays. Perhaps it can produce more Olympians in the future, but it might have to do it under a new name in the future. Eastern Michigan University President Dr. William Shelton in January of 1991, eliminated the Huron nickname and logo. The entire repercussions are not know at the present time, but the meet will survive and continue to flourish under whatever name it is given.

Kermit N. Ambrose - Meet Director 1970-1990

Kermit N. Ambrose retired last year as Meet Manager of the Huron Relays after 21 years. Mr. Ambrose's name has been synonymous with Track and Field and Cross Country in the state of Michigan for nearly 40 years.

Kermit's coaching record at Birmingham Seaholm High School was unsurpassed statewide during his tenure there. Ambrose compiled a 189-23 dual meet record in track and cross country while at Seaholm and won several state championships.

Since retiring from coaching in 1967, Ambrose has been the most active track official in the state of Michigan, working age-group, middle school, high school, and collegiate track and cross country meets - often totaling more than 75 meets in a single season. He served as an official at the NCAA Indoor Championships for 23 years, and was the starter at 10 state track championships. He is a Past-President of the Michigan Interscholastic Track Coaches Association (MITCA).

As director of the Huron Relays, Ambrose saw the meet flourish into one of the largest indoor high school meets in the country, with well over 100 schools competing each year.

At the age of 80, Ambrose has semi-retired from officiating, but still works several local meets and remains an avid track and cross country fan.
