



# Coldwater tracksters split

ALBION — Coach Bob Mullally's small, but talented Lady Cards won their second straight track meet with a 68-60 Twin Valley Conference decision over the Albion Wildcats on Tuesday.

With the win, Coldwater is now 2-4 overall and 2-2 in the league.

Coldwater's Becky Kelly placed first in both the 1,600-meter (6:03.3) and 3,200-meter (12:54.8) and joined the team of Rachel Carrion, Meri Davis and Tami Snyder to win the 3,200-meter relay with a time of 12:23.1.

The Lady Cards' Tina Boester claimed top honors in the 400-meters with a time of 66.7, while Coldwater's Joy Strawser won the 800-meters (2:31.5).

Coldwater's Shannon Goodwin won the discus with a toss of 67-3, while the Lady Cards' Sandy Kontowsky won the high jump at 4-8 and the 100-meter high hurdles (18.4).

Meanwhile, Coldwater's boys team (2-4, 1-3) dropped a 96-41 decision to the Wildcats despite the Cards' Britt Moore outstanding performance where he won the long jump (20-5 1/4) and 300-meter hurdles (44.4) while taking second place in the pole vault (11-6) in his first competition in that event.

Coldwater's Bill Aponte won the 1,600-meter run (4:47.8), while the Cards' Will Sherwood was victorious in the 3,200-meter relay with a time of 10:40.1.

The Cards will host Hastings on Thursday.
