KEARSLEY BROKE three meet records en route to 79 points and the championship of the Corunna Relays. The team of Janairo Brown, Bill Garant, Jason Barry and Gary Kinnee clocked 8:18.7 in the 3,200 relay; Scott Groulx, Rick Tanjonick, Ryan Loisel and Don Baldwin clocked 3:40.2 in the frosh-soph 1,600 relay; and Ben Norder, Lance Forrest, Berry and Brown had a 3:28.6 showing in the 1,600.

All three were records Brown, Tony Fuhr, Garant and Kinne turning in a time of 3:40.2. Forrest, Garant, Norder, Groulx 3:25.3 were second in the sprint medley relay.

Owosso was 12th with 13 points and Clio 13th with nine.

TRACY WALTON set a Kearsley record with a discus throw of 114 feet, 11 inches and joined with Carrie Young to set a Corunna Relays mark of 228-8 as the Hornets finished third in the 14-team field with 63 points.

Frankenmuth (93 points) placed first and Chelsea (68) was second. Corunna (21) was seventh and Swartz Creek (8) was 11th.

Also winning for Kearsley was its 800-meter relay team of Tiffany Kirkland, Chandra Traylor, Nessa Eddy, Jenny Thompson in 1:49.6, and its 1,600 team of Eddy, Thompson, Andrea Cantu and Sherrie Shoter in 4:18.9.
