Beecher levels Big 9 for track titles

Beecher High carried home the heavy envelopes after Thursday's Big Nine Conference track meet at Clio.

The Bucs collected most of the medals while dominating in both the boys' and the girls' meets.

About the only thing Beecher didn't get was a complete results package, showing all of the details of its impressive perfor-

No one else did, either, as a malfunctioning computer program left some details incomplete late Thursday night.

The missing facts won't change the outcome, however.

Beecher made certain of that by rolling up huge margins in both meets.

Coach Marty Crane's boys' team won by 851/2 points and Coach Joe Wilkerson's girls' squad enjoyed a 65-point cush-

Beecher scored 1981/2 points in the boys' meet to earn a share of their 11th Big Nine title in 13 vears, and the girls' team earned 144. Kearsley was second in both meets, with 113 points from its boys' team and 79 in the girls' competition.

The second-place finish in the boys' meet was enough to give Coach Don Marsh's Hornets a share of the league's overall championship which also involves the dual meet portion of ne schedule. Kearsley defeated seccher in a dual meet early in he season.

There was no split in the girls' meet The Lady Bucs won it all after going undefeated against Big Nine teams in dual meets.

Beecher scored in 16 of the 17 events in the boys' meet, missing

only in the 1,600-meter run. The Bucs won seven events including finishes of at least 1-2 in three. Their best event was the long jump where the Bucs ended in the top four positions led by winner Marcus Tipton.

"That was kind of a pleasant surprise," Crane said. "We had five kids in it, but I didn't expect to finish like that.

Beecher high jumper Taron Burgess, the area's first to clear seven feet, accounted for the only dent in the record book. Burgess won his specialty by matching the league record with a jump of

The Bucs' triumphs included victories in all three sprint relays: the 1,600, 800 and 400. Reggie Allen in the 300 hurdles, and Garth Spight in the 400 accounted for Beecher's other individual triumphs.

"We had so many personal bests tonight, this is a night to remember," Crane said.

Kearsley nearly matched Beecher in first places with six, but Coach Don Marsh said his Hornets couldn't compete with the Bucs' depth.

"Most of our people performed very well," Marsh said.

Marsh said Gary Kinnee ran his best races of the season in winning the 1,600 and 3,200 runs for the Hornets with times of 4:23.2 and 9:39, respectively.

Sprinter Greg Thompson reached 22 seconds for the first time in winning the 200, and Janairo Brown turned in his best clocking in taking the 800 run in 1:54.8. Brown ran the leadoff leg on Kearsley's winning 3,200 relay team.

Thompson also won the 100 to join Kinnee among three double winners of individual events.

The other was Carman-Ainsworth's Jon Runyan who defended his titles in the shot put and discus.

Paced by Runyan's 20 points and Amen Miller's victory in the 110 hurdles, the Cavaliers fin-ished a solid third in the boys' scoring with 91 points. No other team had more than 38 points.

Owosso's Jarrod Hoose was the other winner in the pole vault.

Wilkerson's Lady Bucs won 10 events including all four relays

and scored in 13 of 16. "They stayed focused and they ran hard," Wilkerson said. Niketa Williams and sprinter Carmia Marshall ran in two winning relays and also won two individual events as the meet's top scor-

ers with 25 points each. Williams won the 300 and 110 hurdles races in addition to helping in the 1,600 and 800 relays. Marshall won the 100 and 200 sprints while running in the 800

and 400 relays. Chantella Byrd won the 400 in addition to running in two relays for Beecher.

Rhoda Read, Renona Childress, Rhoda Russell and Sheketa Peterson also were part of two winning relays.

Denise Rubin accounted for Beecher's other triumph in the

shot put.

"They're starting to jell now at the right time," Wilkerson said, looking ahead to the state meet in Grand Rapids May 30. "If a couple of our kids had run like that in the regional we'd have placed even more people for the state meet.'

The winners of the other six events were spread among six

Janelle Sheppard led secondplace Kearsley by winning the 1,600, while fourth-place Owosso got a victory from Tressa Rowell in the 3,200.

Clio's Darcie Brasier captured the high jump, Jill Dolphin won the long jump for Powers Catholic, Stacey Seeley took the discus for Carman-Ainsworth and Erin Hughes won the 800 for Davison. Big Nine track
