EAST LANSING — Carson City-Crystal coach Gordon Aldrich hid the Spartans Relays Class C-D championship trophy.

That's right, he hid it so no one could see it. Aldrich accepted the trophy from track guru Paul Pozega and put a jacket over it.

He did that because he wanted to surprise his boys' track team, which was outside waiting on the bus and oblivious to the fact that it had won the prestigious Spartan Relays Friday at Jenison Field House.

"I had no idea," said Aldrich, who was dambfounded when he found out, "We didn't come in expecting to win. We just wanted to have some good performances."

The Eagles finished with 24 points, Besides winning the Class C-D meet, Carson City placed fifth in the combined Class B-C-D meet.

Ypsilanti Lincoln won the Class B event with 61^{1}_{2} points, Beecher was second with 60 and River Rouge was third with 52.

"I figured there'd be a lot of teams in Class B with good distance runners and sprinters," said Aldrich. "We planned on competing in the 800 meters-and-up. This is a meet where you can win if you do well in one area."

Gary Hamilton's Maple Valley Lions picked up where they left off last season when they won the Class C state title.

"Overall, I'm very happy with our performance," Hamilton said. "I thought we could come in and compete for one of the top three or four positions. We performed up to our capabilities."

The Lions' distance medley relay team of Stephanie Bouwens, Holly Taylor. Cheri Sessions and Mindy Shoup placed second in 13:47.7 and the one-mile relay team of Jennifer Phenix, Bouwens, Retha Byrd and Shoup came in third in 4:31.2.

Sessions also finished third in the long jump (4-10) and fifth in the two-mile run (12:54.7).

Eaton Rapids' Kelly Etheridge was second in the high jump with a leap of 5 feet and she was part of the one-mile relay team that placed second with a time of 4:30.7. Heather Hauser ran strong legs in the one-mile relay and distance medley relay.
