

LakeVille, Cavs win Cavalier Classic

Prom Night depleted Carman-Ainsworth's track lineup Friday night, but it didn't decimate the Cavaliers by any means.

The defending Class A state champions hosted 13 schools and they beat them all, scoring 71 points to win the boys portion of the record-filled Cavalier Classic.

LakeVille won the girls' meet with 74 points.

A dozen meet records fell in the 14th annual event and Coach Kenn Domerese's Cavaliers set two of them in avenging last year's second-place finish.

Chuck Thrash and Mike Jackson leaped a combined 13-feet, 1-inch to shatter the old meet record by a whopping 6½ inches. Thrash set an individual school record with a jump of 6-10 that Domerese believes is the best in the state this year.

Their other record came in the 800-meter relay, where the team of James Willingham, Roshawn Jackson, Tennarius Mosley and Mike Spaulding clocked 1:30.

Domerese didn't know what to expect from his troops since many of the Cavalier seniors attended their prom Friday night.

"Some of the guys came and left," Domerese said. "I'm not going to tell the kids they can't go to the prom. That's a big deal for them. So I told them if they wanted to come and run one race and then leave, that was OK. And if they didn't want to come, that was OK, too."

"We thought it would be difficult to win with some of the guys gone. But the younger guys showed up, ran one or two extra races apiece, and did a nice job."

Carman-Ainsworth's other victories came in the 400 and Cavalier Relay, a potpourri event which sees each team run two 100s, one 200 and one 400.

Willingham, Roshawn Jackson and the Mosleys clocked 49:73 in the 400 while Tennarius Mosley, Jackson, Willingham and Thrash came home in 1:34.42 to win the Cavalier.

The only other record in the

boys' meet was set by Swartz Creek's 6,400-relay team of Ben Hunault, Paul Kekel, Marty Allen and Ernie Harwood, who clocked 18:58.31.

The girls' competition saw a staggering nine records shattered in only 13 events. Lakeville and Flushing both set three girls' records.

Lakeville, which set a school mark in the 800, also set meet records in the intermediate hurdles and discus.

The Falcons won the hurdles with a team of Terresha Derossett, Kathy Newberry, Krysta Thomsen and Shelly Periso. Mindy Lincoln and Rhonda Wagner won the discus, while Thomsen, Carrie Young, Cynthia Smith and Wagner teamed in the 800.

Flushing set records in the long jump, 3,200 and distance medley.

Heather Tonda and Megan Swenson won the long jump for the Raiders; Sarah Cole, Jenny Denkins, Kathie Horne, and Caroline Leven won the 3,200; and Cole, Kathie Delaney, Horne and Leven comprised the distance medley unit.

The other girls' records were set by Powers Catholic in the 6,400, Bay City Western in the

shot put, and St. Johns in the 1,600.

Powers won the 6,400 with a team of Amy Newland, Kelly Fishback, Melanie Shoskey and Adriana Guerra.

Domerese wasn't surprised at the number of records set.

"Everybody talks about how good the (C.S.) Mott Relays are," he said. "But last year, I compared our times with the Mott Relays and they were very competitive."
