# LakeVille takes two titles at Cavalier Classic

One of the smaller schools in the field put together a big day at the Cavalier

Classic track meet Friday.

LakeVille, a Class B school, went up against a field made up largely of Class A schools and dominated girls' competition while winning the Class B-C portion of the boys' meet as well.

Host Carman-Ainsworth won the boys' Class A portion of the meet and had the highest boys' total overall with 87 points. In the girls' Class A meet, Grand Blanc edged Flushing 55-54 in a tight battle between Big Nine rivals.

LakeVille coach Darrel Morton said the school's success could be traced to a one big happy team kind of approach.

"We don't have a girls' program or a boys' program," said Morton. "We just have a total track program. Our girls do the same workouts as the boys."

LakeVille's girls used those workouts

to control the girls' portion of the meet as they totaled 83 points.

Most impressive was the Falcons' discus-tossing tandem of Mindy Lincoln and Rhonda Wagner, who combined for a distance of 260 feet, 2½ inches in setting a meet record. Lincoln's portion of the distance, 144-0, was also a school, field and personal best for her and ranks among the top throws in county history.

Needless to say, Morton called Lincoln crucial to the Falcons' goal of winning a state title.

"A girl like Mindy could give us 20 points all by herself," said Morton.

In addition to winning the discus event, the Falcons also placed first in the 400, 800, 1,600, shuttle hurdle, long jump and Cavalier relays.

"Our girls haven't lost a dual meet in seven years," said Morton. "They're 79-0 in that time. Our boys haven't lost in two years. We're just blessed with good, hard-working kids."

Which is the same way Carman-Ainsworth coach Kenn Domerese described his group.

The Cavaliers won the meet for the third year in a row. Domerese said this year's group has proven to be special because not much has been expected of it.

"We lost a ton of kids from last year's team to graduation," said Domerese. "And we lost some other kids we expected to do well for various reasons. But these kids are a good, hard-working crew.

"The nicest thing about them is how quickly they respond to coaching. You ask them to do something and it's done."

The Cavaliers showed versatility in taking six first-places. Carman-Ainsworth athletes won in events ranging from the 400 relay to the 6,400 relay to the shot put.

In addition to LakeVille's dominance in the discus, several

other meet records were set in spite of a lightning delay and cool, windy conditions.

Powers Catholic's girls' 6,400 relay team of Kelsie Gould, Adrianna Guerra, Nicole Darst and Carrie Gould finished in 23:20.3 to break the record set by the Chargers last year by 31 seconds.

LakeVille's girls set a meet record in winning the shuttle hurdle relay in 1:09.52 to surpass the
mark the Falcons set last year.
Flushing's distance medley relay
team broke the record set by
Flushing's 1993 squad. This
year's Raiders crossed the line in
13:37.19 to break the record by
almost two seconds.
