Out-of-towners take hardware in Mott Relays

For the first time in five years, Flintarea teams were shut out at the C.S. Mott Relays.


Kalamazoo Loy Norrix repeated as the girls' champion while Midland took home the boys' title Friday as Flint-area teams failed to win at least one of the crowns for the first time since 1990.

Loy Norrix edged Central's girls 73-67 and Midland easily outpointed Beecher 84-56 in the boys' portion of the 27th annual event at Houston Stadium.

Central may have captured the girls' hardware had it not been for one glaring weakness.

"I didn't have anyone in the shot put," said a disappointed coach Otha Hill, whose team was blanked in that event.

Loy Norrix, on the other hand, earned 10 crucial points by winning the shot put when sisters Chela and Cherina Hubbard teamed for a distance of 58 feet, 51/2 inches. That was one of five events cap-

tured by the Knights.

Laura Edwardson was their top performer, running on two triumphant relay teams while also winning the 1,600 run. Katie Snyder joined Edwardson on the first-place relay teams.

Central won three of the other five events that eluded Loy Norrix in the girls' division. The Indians won the 400and 800-meter dashes, while Shante

Burke — who was on both of those teams — edged teammate Ada Mallov in the 100.

Burke and Malloy teamed in the 400 relay along with Angelina Edwards and Tekila Lewis. Edwards, Mia Malloy and Ada Malloy joined Burke on the 800 team.

Because of the unpredictable weather, no records were set.

Conditions were perfect in the early afternoon hours, but that quickly changed when a thunderstorm caused a 45-minute delay. When the rain clouds passed, the winds kicked up and the temperature dropped about 15 degrees.

"That makes it tough," said Clif Turner, the meet's assistant director. "It's really tough to set any (records) on a day like this. We ran for awhile, then had a break and just sat around."

In the boys' competition, Beecher won four events to Midland's three. But the Chemics' depth was the difference as they picked up points by scoring in 10 of the 13 boys' events.

Beecher's Darnell Wilson, Torry McDaniel, Eric Southland and Emanuel Hare teamed to win the C.S. Mott Relay and all were double winners.

Wilson and Erick English teamed to win the discus relay; McDaniel and Southland were on the first-place 1,600 team along with Justin Phillips and Kenyatta Brown; and Hare captured the high jump relay with Claude Williams.

Grand Blanc's Geoff Besso and Craig Smith helped the Bobcats win two events.

They took the distance medley along with Mike Tremblay and Kris Straham, and were first in the 3,200 with Felix Onown and Diego Harrison.

The only other boys' victory by a Flint-area team was in the shuttle hurdles relay, where Northern's Lavell Hamlin, Jason Fouse, Derrick Lee and James Webb prevailed. Grand Blanc (39) finished third in the boys' event with Northern (38) fourth, Central (19) ninth, Southwestern Academy (15) 10th and Northwestern (0) tied for 13th.

Among the girls' teams, Southwestern Academy (50) was fourth, Northern (23) tied for fifth, Beecher (8) tied for seventh, and Northwestern (3) was 10th.
