TRACK RESULTS, Michigan's High School Track & Field Newsletter, is pleased to announce the selection of its third Michigan High School Track & Field Dream Team. Once again the team was selected using the State Finals as top priority, then going to other championship competitions, including the Midwest Meet of Champions, to help us get the best possible team. We looked at all the results we could find, so if you think we missed someone make sure we get your results next year.

This was another great year for Track & Field in Michigan. The weather stunk, but the performances came around when the weather was remotely nice. Dream Team 3 might be the most interesting to date. Our first Class D member & three Class C performers, with some speed, break up the class A hold. Two members of Dream Team 1 made it back on the team after missing last year. The year was rough on returning Dream Teamers. Six underclass runners made Dream Team 2, one repeated, Todd Snyder. All five of the Dream Teamers that didn't make it return in '96 to try and earn their way back on the team. Ten underclassmen, our largest group yet, made the team this year. The Class of '96 looks tough, but the Class of 1995 has put up some great performances so we look forward to the battle for Dream Team 4.

MEN'S DREAM TEAM COACH OF THE YEAR

TIM CASHEN Comstock Cashen's crew defended their '94 title outdistancing the runner-up by over 40 points. This is the first time since Flint Beecher's string of 4 titles in the late 80's that a Class B boy's team has been able to repeat as champion. Seventeen of last year's points did not score this year, but the Colts did not miss a step. Comstock won 6 of the 7 events they entered, using the legs of Randy Hunt, the first 4 time champion since Tyrone Wheately/Dearborn Hgts Robichaud & UM.

GIRL'S**DISCUS/SHOT PUT**

SUZIE VONBERNUTH/s Okemos Suzie has dominated the state the past 2 years so we will take her in both throws. 2 time shot put champion & a pair of 153' throws at the Lansing Area & Midwestern Meet of Champions. Second Okemos thrower on the team.

HIGH JUMP

JENNY ENGELHARDT/j Battle Creek Lakeview Jenny proved her 5' 10 regional mark was no fluke by defeating 1994 Champ Stacey Thomas. Both will be back in 1996. This will be an event to watch in '96 as three previous Dream Teamers will be competing.

LONG JUMP

MWANZA RUSSELL/s Southfield Returns to the state championship position which she won as a sophomore. Pretty consistent at 18' over her senior year. Member of Dream Team 1. Headed for U of M.

100 METERS

JESSICA CHAMPINE/j Clare Jessica claims the spot with the fastest FAT time but there is a lot of speed returning, including a previous Dream Teamer, so Jessica will have to run fast to repeat.

200 METERS

CHARNELL LYNN/s Willow Run She might be the top sprinter in the state. 23.98 in the 200 meters at the Midwestern Meet of Champions supports the statement after winning the 100-200-400 @ Class B. Member of Dream Team 1 in the 100. EMU bound.

400 METERS

ALGEILA EDWARDS/j Flint Central Another underclasswoman knocks another underclasswoman off the Dream Team, both return for '96. The junior finished fast to defeat the state record holder Julia Ford. Should be a great race next year.

800 METERS

SARAH HERBERT/s Defended her Class A championship with a front running style. Running at Macomb next year.

100 HURDLES

KENYATTA GRISBY/j River Rouge Class B's top hurdler, winning both the highs & lows for the 2nd year in a row. Just a junior so will she make 6 titles?

300 HURDLES

SHAUNETTE SMITH/j Detroit Mumford Another junior hurdler who won a lot of big races throughout the year.

1600 METERS

CHRISTIE ACHENBACH/j Unionville-Sebewaing Area Won a very close Class C battle & had the fastest time & hence the spot on the Dream Team. Quite a few low 5 times in the junior class, look for a fast 1996.

3200 METERS

ALLISON KLEMMER/j Troy Athens Another junior who really ran away with the race at 10:52

DETROIT CASS TECH (Kanisa Williams/j, Lakesha Snoddy/s, Emily Higgins/s, Chantelle Nagbe/j) Replaced the one senior and didn't miss a step.

4x200 RELAY

DETROIT CASS TECH (Lakesha Snoddy/s, Julie Ford/so, Chantelle Nagbe/j, Tracy Ball) Replaced a graduate and one returnee and ran away from the field.

4x400 RELAY

DETROIT CASS TECH (Janelle Toles, Katie Chapman/so, Julia Ford/so, Ayobani Bell) Replaced two seniors and still cruised to their third dream team in a row. A Cass Tech sweep in the sprint relays again this year, the third year for the two longer relays. Coach Smiley has a lot of young talent so they might sweep for the 3rd time in 1996!

4X800 RELAY

CALEDONIA (Shannon Houseman/so, Keri Bloem/so, Barb Warner/so, Sarah Parbel/j) The whole group is returning and 3, Bloem joined this year, were members of last year's Dream Team. Houseman & Warner could conceivably be on four Dream Teams.

With all or the relay runners returning we might just save this disk & save typing them again.

WOMEN'S DREAM TEAM COACH OF THE YEAR **Joe Zomerlet/Caledonia** Won Class B with a bunch of distance runners! The change in rules and the order of events now make the distance runner as valuable as the speed merchants as Caledonia showed. Joe started the girls program at Caledonia and has been there since. They dominate the distances in Michigan as they won the Class B girls cross country title. With all of their points back, and 29 of them sophomores, they should be the team to watch the next couple of years.

THE STATE FINALS

The complete results of the 1995 MICHIGAN HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION STATE FINALS follow. Where information is available the participants grade is given and their performances in previous state final meets. The information for the Upper Peninsula Finals does not include grades or previous results. The symbols used are:

BOYS: There were 16 returning individual state champions in the 4 boy's classes, 9 were successful in their quest for a repeat title. One two time state champion could not make it three. Sixty-two individual boys that scored last year were not able to score this season. Five individuals that changed class did not score in their new class. Class B had both of its returning champions repeat, the other three classes each had half repeat. There were two triple winners, Shay/Class D and Hunt/Class B. Hunt picked up a 4th championship as part of a winning relay.

Five boys were double winners, 3 in the sprints. Allen/Class A, Johnson/Class D and Mack/Class C won two of the sprints in their class. Mack may be considered a quadruple winner as he was on two winning relays. Stempien/Class C and Curry/Class C were the other double winners. Class C had the most double winners and it also had the only three time champions. Curry won the 3200 for the third year in a row. Mack has won the 400 for three year now, as a junior he will have a chance for his 4th 400 title next spring.

Four additional qualifiers earned state championships, 3 in the individual events and one relay.

GIRLS: Defending state champions had a rough year at the Girl's State Meets. There were 26 individual champions able to defend their titles, only 8 were successful. Two, two time champions were not able to make it three, and a record setting winner from '94 could not repeat. Class C was the roughest where only 1 of the 8 returning champions repeated. One individual that won a title in '93 and was not successful in defending her title in '94, repeated the championship this year. Another champion could not repeat in her '94 event, but repeated as a champion by winning a different event in '95.

There was one triple winner, Lynn/Class B. There were six double winners, three in Class C; Feldman, Mulvaney and Champine. The other double winners were Formsmo/Class D and in Class B Gould and Grigsby each won 2 events. There was a total of 127 individual girls that scored last year were not able to score this year. Add to that several individuals that changed class and were unable to score, it was not a good year for returning points.

Additional qualifiers did well at the Finals. 34 additional qualifiers scored, plus 16 relays that were additional qualifiers scored. Five freshmen won state titles.

1995 BOY'S CLASS D STATE FINALS/BANGOR JOHN GLENN

Four state champions returned, half, Johnson/100, Brown/400, were able to repeat. There was one triple winner, Shay/800-distances, and a double winner with Johnson/sprints. Eleven scorers in the '94 Finals were not able to place this year. Four additional qualifiers, half in the discus, and one additional qualifying relay team scored this year.

1995 GIRLS CLASS D STATE FINALS/BANGOR JOHN GLENN

Not a good year for the 9 defending champions in Class D, over half, including a 2 time state champion, were unable to repeat as champions. Lamkin/2x High Hurdle champion still earned an individual title for the third year by winning the low hurdles. In general 1995 was not to nice to '94 scorers as 33 failed to score this year, led by the high jump where 7 of 8 returning jumpers did not place. A double winner last year, Formsmma/long jump & 200, repeated in both events this year. Zuderveen/disc and Hall/high jump were the other champions to repeat. Additional qualifiers were treated well in the girls Class D Championship, 12 out of 17 individual qualifiers scored. This includes all 5 of the additional qualifiers in the high jump. All of the additional qualifiers also scored in the Disc(1), High Jump(1), 200(1) and 800(2). Three of the five additional qualifying relay teams also scored. Two freshmen won titles.
