

# Vikings win 3 events in Mott Relays

The C.S. Mott Relays always seem to bring out the best in the athletes that compete.

Just ask Northern senior Derrick Lee. Lee, who will attend Grambling University next fall on a football scholarship, led the Vikings to victories in the C.S. Mott 800-meter, shuttle and 400 relays at the 29th annual meet Friday at Houston Stadium.

"Our coaches just told us to concentrate and run our races," said Lee, who along with Nelson Lakey ran in all three events.

Lee, Lakey, Robert Manning and Idi Beard ran the C.S. Mott Relay in 1:32.69, and then Lee, Lakey, Jason Fouse and Piero Richardson teamed up to win the shuttle hurdle relay in 1:03.27. The team of Lakey, Lee, Richardson and Jamal Latimore won the 400 meter relay (44.95).

"It's a tradition," said Lee of the Mott Relays. "Everybody likes to come here to see Flint's best."

The area's only other individual winner was Central's 1,600 relay team of John Willie, Chris Lewisk, Paul Vance and Mike Mullen, who blazed over the wet track in 3:32.21.

Mullen ran the anchor leg and was in third place when he got the baton.

"Saginaw was in front of me and my goal was to get Saginaw," he said. "When I kicked it to beat him, it took me past him and then I said, let's go get the leader."

Kalamazoo Loy Norrix, which won three events, nosed out two-time defending champion Midland 60-59 to win the boys' meet.

In the girls' meet, defending Class A champion Ann Arbor Pioneer won 10 of the 11 events to defend its Mott title.

The Pioneers set a meet record in the shuttle hurdle relay (1:01.5), beating the record of 1:02.06 set by Northern in 1989.

The only event Pioneer did not win was the high jump, which was won by Northern's Deana Nolan and Clarissa Elam with a combined jump of 9-8.
