Rats, Powers win Cavalier Classic

The Ann Arbor Huron boys' track team came to the 18th annual Carman-Ainsworth Cavalier Classic track meet Friday and literally ran away with the champions of t onship.

The River Rats finished first in eight of the 15 events and ended the day with 110 points, easily outdistancing host Carman-Ains-worth, who finished in second place with 44 points.

Flushing was right behind the Cavaliers with 43 points. River Rats coach Kent Overby

found the experience thoroughly enjoyable.
