

# Rats, Powers win Cavalier Classic

The Ann Arbor Huron boys' track team came to the 18th annual Carman-Ainsworth Cavalier Classic track meet Friday and literally ran away with the championship.

The River Rats finished first in eight of the 15 events and ended the day with 110 points, easily outdistancing host Carman-Ainsworth, who finished in second place with 44 points.

Flushing was right behind the Cavaliers with 43 points.

River Rats coach Kent Overby found the experience thoroughly enjoyable.

"That was a lot of fun," he said. "Of course, it's just like school, when you're having success, it's a lot more enjoyable."

Overby gave a lot of credit to one sprinter in particular and all his relay teams in general.

"When you have a sprinter like Thabiti Williamson, you're going to win some relay events," he said.

Williamson ran the opening leg of the River Rats' first-place 400, 800, Cavalier and shuttle hurdle relay teams. The Cavalier relay features two 100-meter legs followed by a 200- and a 400-meter leg.

The Powers Catholic girls' team took the top spot with 79 points, 26 better than second-place Fenton. Carman-Ainsworth finished third with 48 points.

Charrise Taylor-Mosby and Monique Williams set a new meet record in the long jump with a combined effort of 32-1/2, beating a mark set by Flushing in 1994 by 4 1/2 inches.

Taylor-Mosby and Williams also ran legs on the Chargers' winning 400, 800 and shuttle hurdle teams.

Nneka Onowu and Michelle Gerard joined Taylor-Mosby and Williams on those sprint relay teams. The Chargers also had winning teams in the 6,400 and distance medley relays.

Kelsie Gould, Paula McIntyre, Emily Petrides and Andi Bachtel won the 6,400 in 23:22.30. Bachtel, Petrides, Gould and Katie McPherson finished the distance medley in 13:38.86.

"We've got a real well-balanced team," said Chargers coach Jim Neumann. "There's a mix of young and old and the older girls really help out the younger ones."

"There's also a real good mix for events. We've got great runners in the distance events and great runners in the sprint and hurdles events."

"(The seniors) have been just fantastic in leading this team."
