Jeff,

You are absolutely right. There were many complaints about the timing being too fast, believe it or not! Our own coaches were down at the finish line the entire day timing on their own stopwatches and they consistently (like every race) timed slower than the official times, sometimes by a very large amount. (a full second in the 400m & almost 2 seconds in the open 800) I have no explanation for it, I have ran at that meet four years straight now and I have no recollection of anything like that ever happening. (The times I gave you were off of our own stopwatches, so they should be pretty accurate.) Its very weird, we were all shaking our heads when they read the winning times on the PA system. Though, I must say that as a runner you can't complain, can you!

Mark-
I'm trying to figure out what happened at the Oxford Invitational. I just got the official results. Usually, the official results will differ from what athletes and coaches report to me in that a few of the times might be a tenth or two slower.

What strikes me as unusual here is that the Oxford official results are quite a bit faster than what coaches reported. Was there a timing discrepancy that you know of?

For instance, you reported Alex Hritcu at 22.8, and they say 22.2
Jeremy Auer at 50.1; they say 49.2
Jason Culbert 39.1, they say 37.7

This didn't just affect your team; the times are faster everywhere. They are so fast that I have trouble believing some of them. In six events, they were the fastest times recorded in the state this year.

Any light you can shed on this would be helpful.
