

Katie Boyles, the three-time state champion from Rochester Adams, stormed to a huge win in last weekend's Oakland County Championships. Her 18:50 led the field by more than a minute, as teammate Shannon Stanley captured the second spot in 19:52. Lisa Canty of Milford ran third in 19:54. Not surprisingly, Adams captured the team win over Milford, 69 to 90. Troy (126), Novi (183), and Bloomfield Hills Marian (196) followed in the 32-team field.

In the boys' Oakland County race, Novi showed why many consider it a favorite to capture a third straight state title. Wildcats Chris Toloff (15:39), Tim Moore (15:58), and Mark Avenius (16:32) swept the top three places. Novi scored 50 to finish ahead of Milford (90), Lakeland (122), and Lake Orion (183).

At the second of the Huron League's Jamborees, Grosse Ile's boys topped Carelton Airport, 47 to 58. The Grosse Ile girls won a close 34-35 decision over Monroe Jefferson.

Northville's boys captured Division I honors at the Ypsilanti Invitational, scoring 53 points to the 72 of Temperance Bedford. Greg Pope of Pinckney won the individual race in 16:42. In Division II, Wyandotte Roosevelt took second to Dover (Ohio).

Ann Arbor Pioneer won the women's Division I title at Ypsilanti with 47 points. Brighton (63) and Livonia Stevenson (106) followed. Livonia Ladywood took second in Division II to Dover, while Trenton won Division III.

The Portage Invitational saw much of the state's top talent gather. In Division I, Plymouth Salem's Donnie Warner led Metro area finishers with his 16:13. State powerhouse Rockford won both boys and girls team titles. Dathan Ritzenhein led the boys in 14:42, while Linsey Blaisdell ran 17:47 to win the girls race.
