

Gabriel Richard Invitational: Novi's top-ranked boys handled a strong challenge from Saline on Saturday. The Wildcats scored 51 points to Saline's 54. Novi took the top two places, led by the stunning course record of senior Chris Toloff, who cruised 15:00 on the challenging Hudson Mills route. He was followed by teammate Tim Moore (15:20) and Saline's Sean Moore (15:41). Birmingham Groves won the Division II title.

On the girls' side, Ann Arbor Pioneer (36) topped Livonia Churchill (75). Junior Jennifer Leichtman of Ann Arbor Greenhills entered the large schools race for an extra challenge and waltzed off with the win in a career best 19:22.
