A couple of familiar winners ran away with trophies in the annual Oakland County track-and-field championships Friday at Clarkston.

Southfield captured its sixth consecutive girls title, and Pontiac Northern collected its seventh straight boys championship (eighth in 10 years).

"Seven in a row for Northern; my hat goes off to them," Clarkston coach Walt Wyniemko said. "That's quite a feat."

While Northern joined Clarkston and Farmington Harrison as favorites into the boys meet, Southfield wasn't labeled as the team to beat in the girls.

But the Rochester Adams girls team elected to forego the county meet to participate in the MITCA Meet of Champions Saturday, opening the door for the Blue Jays, who won six events en route to the title.

"We've finished first now I believe six years and every time it's exciting," Southfield coach Calvin Johnson said. "We scored most of our points in the sprints, which is our strength, and we performed very well in the relays.

"That was nice because we mixed up the relays a little to see what would be our best options and to get us prepared for the state meet. This was a great tune-up."

Southfield senior Melanie Williams scorched the Clarkston track for four wins in the 100, 200 and 400 while anchoring the winning 800 relay.

Lindsay Bond won both hurdles events and also contributed to a Southfield win in the 1600 relay.

While not every team loaded up with its top lineup, opting to let individuals shine in certain events, the meet still provided many exciting races.

Clarkston opened the day with a win in the girls 3,200 relay, and Nicole Fisher, while Nicole Fisher and Rachel Uchman came back to finish one-two in the 800.

In the 1,600, Troy freshman Erin Geldhof outleaned Oxford senior Karen Leroy, and Milford freshman Katie Kramer broke away from the pack to win the 3,200.

In the field events, Ahleah Tagai of Madison Heights Lamphere took the high jump, Walled Lake Central's Sarah Chrzanowski won the pole vault, Birmingham Groves' Loni Grace the shot put and Farmington Hills Mercy's Judy Telford the discus.

As Northern, Clarkston and Harrison locked down the first three positions in the boys meet, the rest of field was tight. Only 17 points separated the fourth- through 10th-place teams.

For Wyniemko's Clarkston team, the runner-up showing was just another page in a great season.

"This is the highest we've every been here," he said. " Any time you can come into such a prestigious meet like this and finish second, that says a lot about your team."

Clarkston dominated the distance events, as the foursome of Matt Haver, David Sage, Kevin Breen and Brett Quantz opened up with a win the 3,200 relay.

Sage came back to top a competitive field in the 1,600, finishing one second ahead of Walled Lake Central's Todd Mobley, who took a huge early lead in the 3,200 and defeated Sage and the rest of the field.

Courtland Keteyian of Lake Orion added a thrilling win in the 800 as he surged past three Clarkston runners over the final 20 meters to win the event.

Pontiac Northern's Daymond Hamler won the 100 and 200 to lead the Huskies, who won five events.

Orchard Lake St. Mary's David McDermott won the high hurdles in a blistering 13.91 seconds, and Harrison's Chris Roberson, Agim Shabaj, Marcus Woods and Kevin Woods won the 400 relay, nipping Northern at the line.

Pontiac Northern captures its seventhstraight county track title

CLARKSTON - For the seventh straight year, the Pontiac Northern boys track team has earned the title of Oakland County champ. The Huskies ran their way to 81 points to win Friday's Oakland County Meet. Host Clarkston was runner-up with 62 points, while Farmington Hills Harrison totaled 54 points to finish third. Walled Lake Central had 42 points, and Walled Lake Western and Milford each finished with 32 points to round out the top five. "That's seven in a row, wow," Clarkston coach Walt Wyniemko said as he congratulated Northern coach James Nelson. "That's a great honor for them." The victory was Northern's eighth in the last 10 years. "We were league champs and we were regional champs, so I expected us to be up there. We've been performing well in the last few weeks," Nelson said. "Our goal was to finish in the top five, and we exceeded our goal.

"I'm just elated. This group did an extraordinary job. They went way beyond our expectations. They were ready to run tonight." Northern, which won five out of 17 events, was led by sophomore sprinter Daymond Hamler, who swept the 100 and 200 meters. Hamler hightailed it 100 meters in 10.52 seconds, just barely edging Roland Burks of Southfield, who finished in 10.75. Hamler's time broke Burk's year-old track record of 11.1. "I had a lot of confidence that I could win it," Hamler said. "Being a sophomore, you have to have confidence because they give all the glory to the seniors, so you have to keep your head up." Running in the outside lane, Hamler came back in the 200 and flew around the rest of the runners, finishing in 22:06 to nip West Bloomfield's Kyle Brown by one-tenth of a second.

"I just kept on fighting my way through it," Hamler recalled. "I just kept pushing. I was trying to get a lead, and as I came around I saw I had a lead, so I just put everything I had into it." Other Northern winners included Brian James, whose time of 49.24 in the 400 meters was good enough to

edge Jeremy Auer of Walled Lake Central, who was four-hundredths of a second slower. Richard Armstrong also won claimed a victory for the Huskies, finishing the 300 hurdles in 38.25 seconds. "I figured I could go 37 (seconds), but I'll take this," said Armstrong, who finished second in the 110 hurdles. "When I lost the 110, I figured God had something in store for me."

Northern's 800-meter relay team of Hamler, Jeremy Hardiman, Jamar Landrum and James was also successful, running the event in 1:28.72 to outlast second-place Farmington Hills Harrison, which came close with a finishing time of 1:29.17. Orchard Lake St. Mary's David McDermott won the 110 hurdles, finishing </FONT><FONT COLOR="#ffff00" BACK="#400040" SIZE=2 PTSIZE=8><B>Lakers Won </FONT></FONT><FONT COLOR="#000000" BACK="#FFFFFF" SIZE=2 PTSIZE=8></B>in a time of 13.91, the fastest finish since 1987, when Rudy Redmond ran the event in 13.8. "I was just trying to run my own race and not focus on anybody else," said McDermott, who finished second at last year's county meet. Other individual winners included, Clarkston's Dave Sage, who won the 1,600-meter run in 4:20.72; Courtland Keteyian (Lake Orion), whose time in the 800 meters was 1:58.27; Lorenzo Parker (Walled Lake Western) who leapt his way to 22 feet, 6 1/2 inches in the long jump; Todd Mobley of Walled Lake Central, who finished the 3,200 meters in 9:32.45; Mike Preston (Auburn Hills Avondale), who tossed the discus 168-1; Milford's Kerry Kramer, who vaulted 13-3 in the pole vault; Royal Oak Kimball's Tim Hughes, who high-jumped 6-3; and Andy Thorn of Waterford Mott, who won the shot put with a throw of 57-33/4.

Southfield-Lathrup (Micah Sheppherd, Tory Phillips, Robert, Boyer and Tony Smith) won the day's last event, the 1,600 relay, in a time of 3:23.93. Harrison's 400-meter relay team of Kevin Woods, Marcus Woods, Chris Roberson and Agim Shabaj won in 42.86. Clarkston took the 3,200 relay in 7:54.74 with the team of Matt Huer, Dave Sage, Kevin Breen and Brett Quantz.
