

In boys cross country, Highland Milford took third in last week's Spartan Invitational in East Lansing, behind Rockford and Cincinnati LaSalle. Junior Nick Kopczyk led Metro area finishers in Division I with his 10th place finish in 16:23.

In the Division II Spartan race, Lahser's Andrew Bauer triumphed in 16:09.

In girls Spartan action, Romeo's Teresa Bongiovanni placed fifth in an epic match-up, as the nationally-ranked Anderson twins from Marquette came south for the only season match-up with Rockford, the nation's number one team. Katie Anderson of Marquette came out on top, her 17:33 shattering the course record.

Sterling Heights Stevenson placed third in the girls Division I team contest behind Rockford and Colerain (Ohio), while Romeo managed fifth.

At the Holly Invitational, Saline won the Division 5 girls race with 60 points to the 90 of Troy. Defending state champion Katie Boyles of Rochester Adams placed first individually in 18:56, while her teammate, Shannon Stanley, clocked 19:39 in third.

On the boys side at Holly, Detroit Catholic Central continued its rise to the top of the state rankings by winning the Division 5 (largest schools) race. Haslett won the Division 4 boys title, with Birmingham Seaholm finishing third. Ryan Detlor of Dearborn Edsel Ford placed second individually to Pinckney sophomore Greg Pope (17:06). St Clair placed second to Richland Gull Lake in Division 2.
