2009 regional results/state qualifiers

THE RATINGS::: This is the final set of **CCIR RANKINGS** for the 2009 Season . The final set of rankings will be Saturday at MIS. The rankings are based on invitational results only! We have been ranking for over 30 years and it is always interesting to compare with the state finals. If we could really call it, then we could just have a coaches meeting in early August, pass out the medals and trophies and then spend the fall..... But where would the fun be.

The rankings have points awarded according to how a team finishes in each invitational they run in, 10 points for first, 9 for second and so on. Some invitational meets are weighted because of the large field and there is a minimum number of teams required in order for a team to earn rating points. The numbers in parentheses indicates the first place coach's votes/first place(s) in invitational meets. The final number is the total number of points for the school, including coach's votes and invitational points. The invitational points are cumulative over the entire season, to a maximum of seven, with only one being counted each week. Coaches vote each week.

We would like to thank all of the panel members who put their time and energy into voting each week. Without their efforts this poll would not have been possible.

It will be interesting to see how things play out. Teams have met a couple of times in invitationals and conference meets splitting or one dominating and then at the regional the other team won. Were some of the wins due to sickness that has been going around the state or injuries. Jordan Tomecek/Milen, the defending D2 individual champion is out for the season with a stress fracture in the foot.

There look to be several interesting races Saturday. Hope everyone is healthy.

State Final Qualifiers 2009

**D1 GIRLS:..... 28 Teams: 48 Individual Girls, 3 Individual Region Champions: 1, 5, 6
127 (118 complete) teams competed in the regional meets. 820 runners competed.**

Rockford finished 4th in the 2009 Finals and looked like the team to beat this year. They moved to the top spot in the ranking this year in the 4th week and have stayed there since. They have a front runner in returning all-stater Katie Rietsema. Jane Hawks won the regional meet for Rockford giving them a proven 1-2. Saline spent a couple of weeks ranked #1 with Pinckney close behind. Saline had the lowest winning regional score with 19 points. Rockford won with 21 points. Grosse Pte South and Troy both have solid teams. South had the 3rd lowest score, winning with 35 points. Defending champion Traverse City Central was third in their region.

Regions were good to 14 of the 17 returning all state runners as they qualified again for the finals. There are 7 of those returning all-state runners: Goethals, Osika, Williams, Clark, Snelgrove, Leptich and Steil; won their regional race. There are two 2009 All-State runners did not appear in their region's result but their team qualified so they could still be at the state meet, **Sara Kroll-s/Livonia Churchill** and **Katie Perkins-s/Traverse City Central**. **Gabrielle Anzalone-j/Grand Blanc**, a 2 time all-state runner, did not appear in the regional results and her team did not qualify.

**D1 BOYS:..... 27 Teams: 50 Individual Boys, 2 Individual Region Champions: 1, 7
132 (125 complete) teams competed in the regional meets. 843 runners competed.**

Defending champion **Ann Arbor Pioneer** started on top of the CCIR polls with the first one and remained there. They are led by three 2009 All-State runners, Nathan Karr, Nick Kern and Adam Kern, no one else is that strong up front. **Detroit Catholic Central** beat Pioneer at West Bloomfield but then Pioneer topped Catholic Central at Holly. **Pinckney** is right in the mix as they beat Catholic Central at its own invitational and again Saturday by 2 points in the regional. All three teams have a 1-5 time spread of less than a minute. Pioneer had the lowest regional score with 23 points while Pinckney won with 39 and Catholic Central had 41. Saline, Saginaw Heritage, Troy and Rockford could be in the hunt. Catholic Central is the only other team in that group with a returning all-state runner, Ricardo Galindo.

Mike Atchoo/Troy, runner-up last year, becomes the runner to aim for in 2009 as the top returning runner. **Nathan Karr/Pioneer** and **Sean Bone/Lake Orion** are the only other returning runners from last year's top 10. Atchoo won the 16 & was 4th in the 8 last spring. Karr was 6th in the 16. The D2 individual champion, Reed Kamyszczek/Kenowa Hills now in D1, should be right there. **Austin Whitelow/Monroe** lost to Karr and beat Kamyszczek at Portage and should be in the race.

All of the returning 2008 D1 All-State runners that returned for the 2009 season qualified for the Finals this year. They are joined by the D2 Individual Champion from 2009, Reed Kamyszczek/Kenowa Hills. Five of these all-state runners won their region race, Atchoo, N Karr, Roche, Galindo and Kamyszczek.

D2 GIRLS:.....: 27 Teams: 62 Individual Girls, 3 Individual Region Champion: 13, 17, 18 132 (128 complete) teams competed in the regional meets. 837runners competed.

The defending D2 champion, **East Grand Rapids**, started the season where they ended last year, on top. They have been first in the **CCIR Rankings** since they started this year. **Grand Rapids Christian** caught them by a dozen points, but East bested Christian 3 times already this year, MUS Elite, Portage and Kent County. The MSU & Portage fields were 30+ team meets which is what the MHSAA Finals will be, so they still must be considered the team to beat. They were are by 3 all-state runners, Lauren Grunwald, Kassidy Clark and Jessie Baloga, the latter 2 won the honor as freshmen 2 years ago. That was the most all-state runners for a D2 Girl's team. Christian was runner-up last year and certainly from the regionals showed they will be right there. They started out slow but have moved up to 3rd in the CCIR polls. **Williamston**, third last year, will be right there in the race again. **East Lansing, Dexter** and **Ada Forest Hills Easter** could be in the mix Saturday.

Dearborn Divine Child has the lowest regional score in D2 as they won their region with 29 points. Grand Rapids Christian had 37 and Williamston won with 42 points.

Jordan Tomecek/Milan won the D2 race as a junior last year but developed a stress fracture and will not be at the Finals to defend her title. **Allyson Winchester**/Middleville Thornapple-Kellogg was the runner-up with **Lauren Grunwald**/East Grand Rapids the next returning runner. Joining these two at the front of the pack should be **Leah O'Connor**/Croswell-Lexington who won both the 8 & 16 last spring. She was listed as an entry but did not appear in the results. Ellen **Junewick**/Forest Hills Eastern and **Taylor Smith**/Otsego maybe ready to move into the top at MIS as both scored in 2 races this past spring. **D3 GIRLS:.....: 28 Teams: 55 Individual Girls, 3 Individual Region Champion: 20, 25, 27
127 (105 complete) teams competed in the regional meets. 762 runners competed.**

Defending champion **Benzie Central** started the season on top of the polls and has slipped to third as the season progressed replaced by **Hanover-Horton**, with **Leslie** in second. Those three finished that way at the Portage Invitational with **Allendale** close behind them. Allendale may have the best 1-2 in any division with John & Wiersma and the definitely have the best 1-2—3 in D3 with Boprst also earning all-state last year. Those 4 teams definitely are the class of D3 and should have a very competitive race Saturday. Hanover-Horton has won with as low as a 35 second spread 1-5.

Hanover-Horton had the low score, 18 for D3 in winning their region and it was one of the lowest of the day. Lutheran North, 22, Benzie Central, 27, and Allendale, 31, were the next low scores.

Devan John/Allendale returns, looking for her third straight individual title. The junior won as a freshman, beating the defending champion, **Devyn Ramsey**/Benzie Central and then beat her again last year. Devyn has ran well this season winning at Portage while finishing behind 2 D1 girls at MSU Elite. **Lyndsey Burdette**/Hanover-Horton is next returning runner. Right there with Lyndsey was **Michaela Carnegie**/Benzie Central. Three more sophomores, **Berlette** is a sophomore, round out the returning top 10 runners from last year. John's teammate, **Ali Wiersma**, and **Brittany Slinker**/Dundee and **Sadie Ringer**/Kent City.

All 13 of the returning D3 All-State runners, still in D3, from 2008 will be running in the 2009 D3 Finals. Changing divison did not stop 3 other 20089 All-State runners from advancing to tge Finals this year. Campbell and Duckworth, who earned the honor in D4 last year, will be running in the D3 race this year. And Mayleben, who earned the honor in D3 last year, will be in the D2 race. Three of the returning runners won their regional race, John, Bernette and Broekema.

Benzie Central, 3rd in 2008, was on top of the **CCIR Polls** when they started **Calvin Christian** assuming the top spot in the 4th week of the rankings. **Hillsdale** shared the top spot for a week with Benzie, finishing the season ranked #2, with Benzie 3rd. **Kent City** beat Calvin in their conference meet a couple of weeks ago and then just lost to them by a point in the regional meet. Those 4 look like the teams to beat Saturday. The remainder of the field may actually determine the outcome of this race as all of the teams string a little, so it will depend on how many other runners fit between people. Should be a very competitive race.

Benzie Central had the lowest score in winng a D3 region, 35, followed by Durand, 38 and Calvin Christian, 39. Kent City was next as a runner-up with 40 points.

The D3 champion from last year graduated but the next 4 runners return. **Blake Allison**/Harrison and **Alex Wilson**/Kent City, 2nd and 3rd respectively last year, were just 2 seconds apart. Wilson's had a great 2008 Track Finals where he won both the 16 & 32 last spring. **David Madrigal**/Durand maybe the favorite as he won at Portage, beatin g Wilson there, and also winning Holly. **Paul Lewis**/Albion, **Justin Bateson**/Blissfield and **Zach Carpenter**/Whitmore are the remaining top 10 from '08 returning.

All 13 of the returning D3 All-State runners, still in D3, from 2008 will be running in the 2009 D3 Finals. Additionally Tennis, who how is in D4 also qualified for the finals this year. There were 6 of the returning all-state runners that won tytheir region this year; Allison, Wilson, Lewis, Madrigal, Bateson and Denton.

No one else has that much strength out front. They started on top when the **DSSIR** Polls stared and have stayed there since. Defending champion **Harbor Springs, Hesperia** and **Battle Creek St. Philip**, the next 3 ranked teams appear the strongest challengers..

Royal Oak Shrine, with 21 points, was the D4 low score regional winner. Harbor Ssprints, 22, St. Philip, 36, and Manton, 38, were the next lowest scores.

Bridget Bennett/Sacred Heart won the D4 title in 2008, leading a group of underclassmen to the finish line, as the first 7 runners, alst year, were all underclassmen. She won the race by 12 seconds. There will be 2 D4 Individual Champions inthe race as**Lindsay Neal**/North Muskegon won the race as a freshman in '07 and was 16 seconds off the pace last year, finishing 3rd is back again. **Melinda Palinkas**/Saranac was the runner-up with **Alexandria Wessels**/Harbor Beach, **Nicole Wurster**/Homer and **Megan Crandall**/Beal City all within 35 seconds of Bennett. This sets up the potential for a very competitive race Saturday. Wurster certainly put herself in the picture for the individual champion Saturday as she won both the 16 & 32 last spring beating many of her competitors for the cross title on the track last spring.
